NGUYEN HUU THO SPEECH AT 11 JUN RECEPTION FOR NUFC-RGNUC DELEGATION

Hanoi in Vietnamese to Vietnam 1430 GMT 3 Jul 74 D

[Text of speech by PRGRSV Chairman Nguyen Huu Tho at an 11 June reception in honor of a visiting NUFC-RGNUC delegation led by Khieu Samphan-read by announcer]

Vietnam and Cambodia are two familiar neighbors. Our two peoples drink water from the same source, live side by side and are closely united not only in struggling for survival but also in building their own countries into prosperous ones. This close solidarity and neighborliness constitute the invincible strength of our two nations and the key to every success of our two armies and peoples. We are very proud that our age-old, close, deep and faithful relationships have helped our two nations overcome so many challenges and hardships and will enable our two nations to live side by side forever and to win continuous success.

Our enemies—the U.S. imperialists and their henchmen—have continuously tried to undermine the fraternal solidarity of the Indochinese peoples. The U.S. imperialists' policy of aggression aimed at imposing neocolonialism upon our countries involves efforts to sow internal dissensions within each of the three nations of Vietnam, Cambodia and Iaos and also to create disunity among these three nations. However, the U.S. imperialists have met with bitter defeat. The historic joint communique of the Indochinese Peoples' Summit Conference has reflected more clearly than ever the militant solidarity and unshakable friendship and neighborliness between our two peoples and among the three Indochinese peoples.

The liberated area in Cambodia covers more than 90 percent of the territory and more than 85 percent of the population. A large and firm solidarity bloc has been established. The people's revolutionary administration has been set up throughout the liberated area. The revolutionary armed forces are invincible. [applause]

The Cambodian armed forces and people, developing their winning and strong position, have relentlessly attacked the enemy both in the dry and rainy seasons and have achieved victories on all battlefields. In particular, the repeated offensives of the Cambodian Revolutionary Armed Forces in Phnom Penh and the seething struggle of the people in enemy--temporarily controlled areas in the recent past have driven the United States and its henchmen into a more and more precarious situation.

The great military and political successes of the fraternal Cambodian Armed Forces and people have led to extremely important diplomatic successes, thus contributing to further heightening the prestige of the NUFC, and the RGNUC on the international stage. We profoundly admire and warmly greet the outstanding and resounding feats of arms of the heroic Cambodian people under the correct leadership of the NUFC and RGNUC. [applause]

Dear distinguished Cambodian guests, ladies and gentlemen and friends:

The Paris agreement has marked the grest successes of historic and epoch significance for the entire Vietnamese people's anti-U.S. national salvation cause. These successes have opened a new and beautiful prospect for the South Vietnamese people in their struggle for building a peaceful, independent, democratic, neutral and prosperous South Vietnam to advance toward peacefully uniting the fatherland, thus contributing to safeguarding peace in Indochina, Southeast Asia and the world.

For more than a year, under the leadership of the NFLSV and the PRGRSV, our people have resolutely struggled for the thorough observance and scrupulous implementation of the Paris agreement, and at the same time striven to heal the wounds of war and build a strong liberated area, and we have won many initial successes in various fields. Khieu Samphan Speech at 11 Jun Reception

[Text of speech by Deputy Prime Minister Khieu Samphan at an Il June reception given by PRGRSV Chairman Nguyen Huu Tho--read by announcer]

[Text] His Excellency Nguyen Huu Tho, chairman of the NFLSV Central Committee Presidium and chairman of the Advisory Council to the PRGRSV; leaders of the NFLSV and the PRGRSV; ladies and gentlemen and friends:

On behalf of the NUFC-RGNUC delegation, I express my profound gratitude to His Excellency Nguyen Huu Tho, chairman of the NFLSV Central Committee Presidium and chairman of the PRGRSV Advisory Council, for organizing this grand reception to greet our delegation.

We are very happy to be invited by the PRGRSV to visit the Republic of South Vietnam, and we have visited Quang Tri Province. We convey to the South Vietnamese people and the PLAF the greetings from their comrades in arms and the most profound revolutionary sentiments from the Cambodians and the CPNLAF.

The heartfelt words which Chairman Nguyen Huu Tho has just used to hail the victories of our Cambodian troops and people, as well as the solemn and cordial welcome which the South Vietnamese troops and people have extended to our delegation, are brilliant manifestations of the South Vietnamese people's bofty revolutionary sentiments on behalf of the Cambodian people who are holding high the banner of determination to struggle unyieldingly against the U.S. imperialist aggressors and their lackeys—the Lon Nol-Sirik Matak-Son Ngoc Thanh-In Tam-Cheng Heng-Long Boret-Sosthene [Fernandez] clique.

In their protracted and persevering anti-U.S. national salvation struggle, the South Vietnamese people have won great, strategic victories that have had global repercussions. The South Vietnamese people and the PLAF have defeated the special war, the limited war and the Americanized war.

Through a steadfast, difficult, resolute, unyielding, and extremely brave struggle filled with sacrifices, our people and national liberation armed forces have won many new successes of strategic significance. At present our liberated areas occupy 90 percent of the entire territory, includes 5.5 million out of the 7 million Cambodian people, while the enemy controls only small plots of land which can only maintain contact with each other by plane.

The enemy does not possess cultivable land, have an economy, nor can it hold the people.

In Phnom Penh and a number of small cities which the enemy still temporarily controls, the people, masses, workers, laborers, youths, pupils, students, teachers and other patriotic people, combined with daily attacks from outside by the national liberation armed forces, have risen up and resorted to increasing revolutionary violence to oppose to the traitors and their U.S. imperialist masters. During May and the beginning of fune, the bonzes, youths, pupils, students, teachers, workers, laborers, and other patriotic people in Phnom Penh demonstrated to manifest their unanimous opposition force against the Ion Nol-Sirik Matak-Son Ngoc Thanh-Cheng Heng-In Tam-Long Boret-Sosthene [Fernandez] traitor clique which is the aggressive tool of the U.S. imperialists in Cambodia. Presently, this movement has widely spread to all strata of people right in the heart of the enemy. The traitors have used very cruel armed terrorization but have been unable to repress the masses movement. All strata in Phnom Penh have united with pupils and students to struggle against the traitors with a high revolutionary resolution and spirit which have resulted in the shameful death of one of their ministers and a high-ranking official.

The pressure of the Cambodian People's Armed Forces and people, combined with the resistance of the people, masses, bonzes, workers, laborers, youths, [words indistinct], and civil servants in the enemy's temporary controlled areas, has brought about more defeats, increasing decline, and more conflicts and contradictions among the enemy ranks which cannot be brought together by any measures taken by the United States. These facts demonstrate the enemy's utter decadence in the military, political and economic fields. This decadence will continue until the enemy collapses completely. No matter how cunning the strategems used by the U.S. imperialists may be, they absolutely cannot save the Phnom Penh traitors and their regime.

At present the prestige and influence of the NUFC chaired by Samdech Chief of State Norodom Sihanouk and of the RGNUC with Samdech Penn Nouth as prime minister have been enhanced continuously in the international arena. More than 60 freedom and justice-loving countries have officially recognized the RGNUC as the sole genuine and legal government of the Cambodian nation and people.

The successes won by the CPNLAF and Cambodians have been due to their correct political lines, their stand of independence, self-sufficiency and enduring hardships as well as their efforts to build forces from all standpoints. REPORTAGE ON 12 JUN QUANG TRI WELCOME FOR KHIEU SAMPHAN

Liberation Radio [Clandestine] in Vietnamese to South Vietnam 1400 GMT 3 Jul 74 S

[Report on a 12 June meeting in Quang Tri Province to welcome the NUFC-RGNUC Delegation]

[Text] Dear Friends, the large conference hall of the People's Revolutionary Committee in Quang Tri Province, on the evening of 12 June, shone with dozens of colored lights. On a peaceful green setting, the Cambodian national flag and the PRG flag, facing each other, symbolized the cemented friendship and militant solidarity between the Cambodian and Vietnamese nations in the same U.S.-fighting combat trench. Obviously, the cause of the present tension in South Vietnam lies in the stubborn desire of the United States to cling to the Nixon doctrine in an attempt to impose U.S. neocolonialism on South Vietnam and other countries in Indochina, and in the deliberate desire of the Nguyen Van Thieu administration to serve as an instrument to implement U.S. neocolonialism and oppose the Paris agreement on Vietnam and peace, national reconciliation and concord. As a matter of fact, the South Vietnamese people must exercise their sacred right of self-defense to protect peace, the liberated zone, the people's lives and property and the achievements of the revolution. The South Vietnamese people have resolutely and appropriately punished the Nguyen Van Thieu administration for its acts of war. By so doing, they are positively protecting the Paris agreement on Vietnam and safeguarding peace in Indochina, Southeast Asia and the world. [applause]

On the basis of the respect for each country's independence, sovereignty and territorial integrity, we pledge to try our best to protect and further consolidate the great friendship and close militant solidarity between the two peoples. We firmly believe that this historically significant friendly visit of the NUFC-RGNUC delegation will further consolidate the great friendship and militant solidarity between the Vietnamese and Cambodian peoples. [applause] We sincerely hope that you--the high-ranking envoys of the heroic Cambodian people--will achieve brilliant success in your friendly visit. [applause] May the Cambodian people's heroic anti-U.S. national salvation struggle achieve complete victory. [applause] May the great militant solidarity and friendship between the South Vietnamese, Cambodian and Lao peoples last forever. [applause] The Just undertaking of the three Indochinese peoples will certainly achieve complete victory. [applause] [end recording]

The conference hall reverberated with long applause when Chairman Nguyen Huu Tho presented Deputy Prime Minister Khieu Samphan with a red scroll bearing the golden words in Vietnamese and Cambodian: "The great militant solidarity and friendship between the South Vietnamese and Cambodian peoples will last forever."

His Excellency Nguyen Huu Tho, chairman of the NFLSV Central Committee Presidium and chairman of the PRGRSV Advisory Council; His Excellency Nguyen Doa, PRGRSV vice president; leaders of the NFLSV and PRGRSV; and ladies, gentlemen and friends: On behalf of the NUFC-RGNUC delegation and on my own behalf, I extend my warmest greetings to all of you for organizing this solemn meeting to welcome our delegation. This is a new manifestation of the South Vietnamese people's lofty revolutionary sentiments on behalf of our Cambodian people, who are holding high the banner of unyielding and stalwart struggle against the U.S. imperialist aggressors and the traitorous lackey Lon Nol-Sirik Matak-Son Ngoc Thanh-Cheng Heng-In Tam-Long Boret-[Sosthene] Fernandez clique. Through you we extend to the Quang Tri people and all brother Vietnamese people our warmest fraternal greetings. [applause]

Dear gentlemen and friends, will you kindly allow me to briefly present the situation in Cambodia: The war to liberate the Cambodian nation and people and to oppose the U.S. imperialists and their lackeys has been waged for 4 years now. In the course of their very brave and fierce struggle against the U.S. imperialists and their lackeys, who are extremely cruel, and against the extremely barbarous Phnom Penh traitors, our Cambodian people and CPNLAF have done their utmost, endured every sacrifice and repeatedly won strategic victories. These victories have been won following the 18 March 1970 coup d'etat, and have been accompanied by large uprising-type demonstrations staged by our people who have eroded the traitorous puppet administration piece by piece and who have seized rifles from the enemy and attacked it. We initially and victoriously opposed the policy of Americanizing the war by defeating the aggressor U.S. infantrymen in May and June 1970, and we scored achievements in opposing the U.S. imperialists! policy of using the Saigon puppet troops to wage an aggressive war in Cambodia in 1970-71. We have victoriously opposed the policy of Cambodianization of the war by repeatedly defeating the traitorous Lon Nol-Sirik Matak-Son Ngoc Thanh-Cheng Heng-In Tam clique's armed forces.

We victoriously opposed the policy of Americanizing the war by the use of its Air Force, in defeating the U.S. Air Force's bombing of Cambodia for 195 days and nights, and we have now occupied positions on the doorstep of Phnom Penh itself. [applause] [end recording]

Deputy Prime Minister Khieu Samphan's speech was interrupted by resounding applause when he expressed the resolute and strong support of the NUFC, the RGNUC and the fraternal Cambodian people for our people's previous anti-U.S. national salvation struggle, as well as for our present struggle aimed at insuring a scrupulous and strict implementation of the Paris agreement.

[LPA from North Vietnam [Clandestine] in English to East Europe and the Far East at 1519 GMT on 3 July provides the following quotation from Khieu Samphan's remarks at the 12 June meeting: "In the past, at present and in the future, Cambodia has always pursued its line of independence, peace, neutrality, non-alliance and of broad unity with all the countries in the world on the principle of respect for independence, sovereignty, equality and mutual benefit in order to receive the assistance from the world people and to contribute its part to the cause of the world people against imperialism and colonialism old and new. With such an unchanging stand, we resolutely support the Provisional Revolutionary Government of the Republic of South Vietnam and the South Vietnamese people, and the six-point proposal advanced on March 22, 1974, by the PRGRSV.

["We sternly denounce the U.S. imperialists and the Nguyen Van Thieu administration for violating in a serious manner the Paris agreement on Vietnam." The vice-premier affirmed: "The militant solidarity between the peoples of Cambodia and South Vietnam will ceaselessly develop and last forever. No enemy can break it. Our two peoples will win final victory in their struggles against the aggressors and their henchmen."]

In his speech delivered at the solemn reception in honor of the Cambodian delegation, Chairman Nguyen Huu Tho said: "On the basis of respect for the independence, sovereignty and territorial integrity of each country, we are determined to do our utmost to defend and further tighten that very lofty and fine friendship and militant solidarity. We are firmly convinced that this friendly visit by Vice Premier Khieu Samphan, Special Adviser leng Sary and the NUFC-RGNUC delegation to the Republic of South Vietnam will contribute to strengthening even more the friendly relations and fraternal cooperation between the Cambodian and South Vietnamese peoples."

With their recent resounding victories, the Cambodian people's resistance against the aggression of the United States and its lackey is a great example of immortal heroism. By staging a reactionary coup on 18 March 1970 and by massively introducing U.S. and Saigon puppet troops into Cambodia, the U.S. imperialists thought they could beat down and swallow alive the freedom and peace loving kingdom of Cambodia.

However, they miscalculated. Just as in South Vietnam and Laos, the U.S. imperialists and their lackey clique of Lon Nol, Sirik Matak and Son Ngoc Thanh in Cambodia have run into the resolute resistance and the valiant and unyielding combat spirity of the Cambodian people.

Under the clearsighted leadership of the NUFC headed by Samdech Chief of State Norodom Sihanouk and the RGNUC with Samdech Penn Nouth as premier and Mr Khieu Samphan as vice premier, the Cambodian people and armed forces have overcome all difficulties to score great victories. Under the direction of the NUFC political program and the direct guidance of various in-country organs, the Cambodian people and armed forces have continuously developed their offensive initiative, and for more than the past 4 years have scored great and comprehensive victories that are being used as a firm foundation for final victory.

To date, the Cambodian people and armed forces have put out of action hundreds of thousands of enemies, including 12,000 U.S. aggressors. They have courageously faced the modern U.S. Air Force, liberated more than nine-tenths of the territory and more than 5.5 million of the 7 million inhabitants of Cambodia, and dealt continuous extremely heavy punitive blows to the U.S. imperialists and their Phnom Penh lackey clique.

Particularly, in the past 7 months of the dry season from November 1973 thru May 1974, the Cambodian people and armed forces eliminated or captured alive 94,000 enemy troops, seized 24,000 assorted weapons, destroyed 344 tanks and armored cars, set ablaze or damaged 635 war vessels, downed or damaged 102 aircraft, overran more than 500 enemy positions and liberated 20,000 people.

The successive attacks of the Cambodian people and armed forces along with the seething struggle of all strata of people in the temporarily enemy-controlled areas have driven the United States and its lackey clique of Lon Nol, Sirik Matak and Son Ngoc Thanh into a precarious situation, and have bankrupted the Nixon doctrine in Cambodia.

At the same time, they have carried out such tricks as cease-fire in-place and deceitful peace negotiations so that they may retrieve their completely losing posture and consolidate their forces and later fight us when an opportunity arises.

"But our Cambodian people and the CPNLAF are determined to continue their attacks without compromise or retreat until total victory."

The South Vietnamese people well understand that the victories of the Cambodian people are the common victories of the three Vietnamese, Cambodian and Iao peoples against the common enemy, the U.S. imperialists and their henchmen. These victories also constitute a great encouragement and support to the present struggle of the South Vietnamese people.
