## AKI HAILS DRV-RGNUMC RELATIONS, FRIENDSHIP ASSOCIATIONS

[Text] Cambodia, 13 February, AKI--Cambodia and Vietnam are neighbors bound by long-standing friendly relations. The Cambodian and Vietnamese peoples have an old tradition of struggle against common enemies, particularly against the U.S. imperialists and all their lackeys. ## SOMPHOU OUDOMVILAY RETURNS FROM PRC WITH LOANS

Regarding the trade agreement signed by Laos and China, Lao Ambassador to Peking Lian Pravongviangkham reported that following the 5 February signing of the Laos-China agreement on trade assistance the PRC Government has decided to grant loans to Laos to buy products from China such as medicines, trucks, canned food, textiles, construction material and oil.

## THIRD DRV TRUCK CONVOY ARRIVES IN PAK SANE

In an atmosphere of cordiality and mutual understanding, the acting premier answered the questions raised by the members of the King's Privy Council concerning the dissolution of the Vientiane "national assembly."

## DEMONSTRATIONS ON NATIONAL ASSEMBLY ISSUE BANNED

[Text] At 1015 today, Oudai Souvannavong, vice minister for information, propaganda and tourism and government spokesman, held a weekly press conference at the Ministry of Information, Propaganda and Tourism. The spokesman reported that the cabinet has decided to ban demonstrations on the 7th National Assembly issue and that it appointed Tiao Vannaseng provincial governor of Houi Sai. Tiao Vannaseng will retain his present position as deputy commander of the 1st Military Region.
