Liberation Radio (Clandestine) in Vietnamese to South Vietnam 0500 GMT 1 Aug 70 S

[Commentary: "Let us warmly greet the voice of the just cause, the voice of determination to fight and win of the heroic Cambodian people"]

[Text] The anti-U.S. struggle for national independence, peace, and neutrality of the Cambodian people is again marked with another shining event.

This morning, 1 August, "the Voice of the National United Front of Kampuchea," for the first time, has broadcast the true voice of the stalwart, indomitable Khmer people who have been holding guns to determinedly fight and defeat the U.S. aggressors and their lackeys. [Text] Amid the brilliant exploits of the Cambodian troops and people in Kirirom and the resounding victories of the southern troops and people on Hill 935 in the Tri-Thien area, our southern people are very happy and enthusiastic because of the birth of the "Voice of the National United Front of Kampuchea." We welcome the voice of the just cause, the victorious voice of the fraternal Cambodian people. We heartily greet the new success of the Indochinese peoples' front against U.S. aggression.

Under the leadership of FUNK headed by the venerated and beloved Samdech Chief of State Norodom Sihanouk, coordinating actions with the fraternal Vietnamese and Laotian peoples, and enjoying the strong support of the world's people, the Cambodian people's movement against the U.S. aggressors and the lackey Lon Nol-Matak clique has made great strides of historic significance. In only four months of armed struggle against the Americans and their lackeys, the fraternal Cambodian people have liberated many vast areas including a number of provincial and district capitals.
