NFLSV RAPS U.S. AGGRESSION AGAINST CAMBODIA

[Text] Hanoi--The commission for foreign relations of the NFLSV Central Committee, has issued a statement condemning the United States for increasing its slanders, threats, provocations, and acts of aggression against the Kingdom of Cambodia, according to LIBERATION PRESS AGENCY.

The statement, dated 10 August, particularly condemned the U.S. air raids on Svay Ngong village, Prey Veng Province, on 29 June and on Chantrea village, Svay Rieng Province, on 11 July, and the encroachment upon Cambodia's territorial waters by the U.S. warship LCU 1577 on 17 July.

Meanwhile, the statement pointed out, the U.S. authorities and papers continued to fabricate many fantastic stories in their campaign of slanders and threats against Cambodia.

The statement stressed: It is clear that the campaign of slander launched by the U.S. authorities and papers against Cambodia only aims at camouflaging the U.S. acts of provocation and aggression against Cambodia--a sovereign, independent, and neutral country.

It went on: The National Front for Liberation and the people of South Vietnam condemn the U.S. aggressive and bellicose policy against the Kingdom of Cambodia and warmly support the policy of the Cambodian Government and people led by Head of State Samdech Norodom Sihanouk, which consists of firmly defending the independence and neutrality of Kingdom of Cambodia within its present borders.

The National Front for Liberation and the people of South Vietnam are firmly convinced that the Cambodian Government and people, supported by all peace- and freedom-loving peoples in the world, will certainly foil all aggressive maneuvers of the U.S. imperialists and their henchmen.

For their part, the National Front for Liberation and the people of South Vietnam will unceasingly intensify their struggle to completely defeat the U.S. aggressive policy and will strengthen their solidarity with the fraternal Khmer people in the struggle against the common enemy--the U.S. imperialists, thus contributing to the defense of independence and people in Indochina and Southeast Asia, the statement concluded.
