NFLSV REPRESENTATIVE PRESENTS CREDENTIALS

(Text) Hanoi, 1 August--Prof. Nguyen Van Hieu, representative of the South Vietnam National Liberation Front in the Kingdom of Cambodia, was received on 30 July by Samdech Norodom Sihanouk, head of state of the Kingdom of Cambodia, according to the LIBERATION PRESS AGENCY correspondent in Phnom Penh.

Prof. Nguyen Van Hieu presented to the Cambodian head of state a letter from Lawyer Nguyen Huu Tho, president of the Presidium of the NFLSV Central Committee, accrediting him as head of the permanent mission of the NFLSV in the Kingdom of Cambodia.

Samdech N. Sihanouk spoke of the Khmer people's joy at the establishment of relations of a state character between the NFLSV and Cambodia. He warmly hailed the great victories recorded by the South Vietnamese people under the leadership of the NFLSV, and strongly condemned the stubborn, aggressive schemes and acts of the US imperialists and their henchmen against the Vietnamese and Khmer people. He reiterated the stand of the royal government and people of Cambodia to always support the South Vietnamese people's just resistance against the US aggressors and for national salvation.

For his part, Prof. Nguyen Van Hieu conveyed to the head of state, the royal government, and the fraternal people of Cambodia the sincere thanks from the NFLSV and people. He warmly hailed the Khmer people for the well-deserved counterblows they had dealt at the US imperialists and the puppet Thieu-Ky clique during the latter's recent violations of Cambodian territory. He also brought up the South Vietnamese people's determination to drive from their country the US aggressors, who are sowing suffering for both the peoples of Vietnam and Cambodia.

Earlier, on 29 July, Prof. Nguyen Van Hieu was received by Son Sann, Cambodian premier, and Pen Nouth, government counselor.
