NUFC MEMBERS IN PEKING CONDEMN SHAM PEACE, CEASE-FIRE

[Text] Peking, February 15, 1973 (HSINHUA)--Members of the National United Front of Cambodia now in Peking held a meeting on February 8 condemning the traitors Lon Nol, Sirik Matak and Son Ngoc Tharh who under the instigation of their U.S. master are peddling sham "peace" and "ceasefire" in Cambodia to deveive public opinion at home and abroad, according to AKI yesterday.

A resolution unanimously adopted at the meeting express full support for the January 26 statement issued by Head of State of Cambodia Samdech Norodom Sihanouk, Prime Minister Penn Nouth and Deputy Prime Minister Kheiu Samphan and the January 28 statement issued by ministers Hou Yuon and Hu Nim. The two statements embody the aspirations of the Cambodian people of various strata, the resolution said.
