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LRY 1/4/TS PRGRSV-NFLSV DELEGATION VISITS 25-29 DEC

Liberation Radio [clandestine] in Vietnamese to South Vietnam 1000 GMT 4 Jan 75 BK

[Text] On the morning of 25 December 1974 a delegation of the NFLSV and PRGRSV with Chairman Huynh Tan Phat as head and Defense Minister Tran Nam Trung as deputy head paid an official friendship visit to the Cambodia liberated zone. The delegation comprised Foreign Minister Mrs Nguyen Thi Binh, Vice Minister to the Chairman's Office Ung Ngoc Ky and PRGRSV Vice Minister of Information and Culture Thanh Nghi. The delegation was accompanied by several cadres and specialists.

Deputy Prime Minister Khieu Samphan, concurrently minister of national defense and CPNLAF commander-in-chief, and his excellency Hu Nim, RGNUC minister of information and propaganda, went to an area near the Vietnam-Cambodia border to welcome the Vietnamese guests. Also present at the reception site were Mrs (Se), women's representative in eastern Cambodia, many CONLAF cadres and combatants and local people.

Amidst resounding applause, their excellencies Khieu Samphan and Hu Nim cordially embraced Chairman Huynh Tan Phat and Minister Tran Nam Trung while Mrs (Se) and Minister Mrs Nguyen Thi Binh, and in hand, engaged in pleasant, intimate conversation.

The two Cambodian leaders and cadres then led the delegation to the official reception site. At precisely 1930 on 26 December 1974 the motorcade carrying the Vietnamese guests arrived at the official reception site. A banner reading "warmly welcome the Vietnamese militant friends" in both Vietnamese and Cambodian was solemnly strung across a welcoming porth.

Present to greet the Vietnamese guests were their excellencies Minister of the Interior, Communal Reforms and Cooperatives Hou Youn, Minister of Justice and Judicial Reforms Prince Norodom Phurissara, Minister and Chairman of the NUFC committee in Phnom Penh Chey Chum as well as many high-ranking CPNLAF cadres and combatants and representatives of the various respectfully presented Chairman Huynh Tan Phat, Minister Tran Nam Trung and other guests with red bouquets. The talk took place in an atmosphere overbrimmed with the fraternal cordiality and solidarity between two nations, two close neighbors who are fighting against a common enemy, the U.S. imperialist aggressors and their henchmen. [Text] Cambodia, 3 January, AKI-At the end of the talks held on 27 December in the Cambodian liberated zone between the NUFC-RGNUC delegation led by Khieu Samphan, RGNUC deputy prime minister and minister of national defense and CPNLAF commander in chief, and the NFLSV-PRGRSV delegation led by Huynh Tan Phat, vice chairman of the presidium and secretary general of the NFL Central Committee and chairman of the PRGRSV council of ministers, the following joint statement was issued:
