[Text of PRG Foreign Ministry 25 October statement]

Assembly a draft resolution designed to counter the positive proposal put forth by the Socialist and nonalined countries calling for the ouster of the country-selling Lon Nol clique from the United Nations and for restoration of the RGNUCs legitimate and legal position at the United Nations.

As everyone knows, the U.S. administration is stremuously seeking to ward off the collapse of the puppet Phnom Penh regime in the political, military and diplomatic fields, in the hope of continuing to use it as a tool to prolong the war and implement U.S. neocolonialism in Cambodia.

The South Viernamese people and the PRGRSV resolutely support the correct stand adopted by the RGNUC--that is, Cambodia's representation at the United Nations is an undeniable prerogative. Only the government that genuinely represents the interests of the Cambodian people and nation is entitled to this prerogative.

The Cambodian problem must be solved in accordance with the political action program of the NUFC, of which Samdech Chief of State Norodom Sihanouk is chairman, with a view to building an independent, peaceful, neutral, democratic, and prosperous Cambodia with territorial integrity.

With the resounding victories, with 90 percent of Cambodian territory and 80 percent of the Cambodian population being completely liberated; with a state that is completely independent politically, military and economically; and with an administration serving the true interests of the people, the RGNUC is obviously the sole genuine and legal government of the Cambodian people, whereas the puppet Phnom Penh administration is only a handful of U.S. lackeys, who are living on the war and U.S. aid and who are not qualified to represent anyone.

In essence, the Cambodian problem originates in the U.S. imperialist aggression and intervention. To proceed toward restoring peace in Cambodia, the United States has no alternative but to totally end its aggression and interference in the internal affairs of Cambodia and completely suspend its support for the country-selling lackey clique
