SUBJ: (C) Declaration of the Provisional Revolutionary
Government on the Situation of Cambodia.

Item I: (3 pages, typewritten; B-5) Letter, dated 26 Mer 70, prepared by an unidentified individual ((possibly of the Provisional Revolutionary Government of the Republic of South Vietnam)), contains a declaration of the ((VC)) Provisional Revolutionary Government of the Republic of South Vietnam on the situation in Cambodia. Document states that during the last decade, the US imperialists have continuously advocated a policy of moddling in the internal affairs of different nations in Indo-China. The US also plans to convert these nations into new colonies dotted with military bases. The Nixon Administration prolongs the aggressive war by advocating the Vietnamization program of the war ((in Vietnam)), and escalates the war in Laos. The US also spares no efforts in undermining the solidarity and the fighting spirit of the people of these nations.

Particularly in the beginning of March 1970, the henchmen of the US imperialists in Cambodia headed by Lol Nol, initiated a campaign against the people of Vietnam, and coordinated with the Saigon Puppet Administration to check our resistance against the US. Actually, the US imperialist and those who advocate a coup d'etat in Cambodia, are acting against the interests of the Khmer people, and promoting a program to convert Cambodia into a military base and a new colony of the US, implementing the "Asian theory" of President Nixon, by using the Asians to fight the Asians.

Since its establishment in Jun 69, the Provisional Revolutionary Government of the Republic of South Vietnam already expressed its own policy towards Cambodia as follows: "Foster a good friendship with Cambodia; respect the independence, sovereignty and neutrality of Cambodia; recognize and honor. the integrity of Cambodia with the existing border; and do not interfere with the internal affairs of each other."

The Provisional Revolutionary Government of the Republic of South Victnam greatly appreciates the hearty support of the people of Cambodia and ((former)) Chief of State Norodom Sihanouk backing our resistance against the US.

A handwritten annotation on the reverse side of last page reads: ((Comrade)) Thieu and other personnel are on temporary duty ((at)) K ((possibly Khmer, and meaning in Cambodia)).
