[Text] Peking, August 25 (HSINHUA) -- Following is the full text of the speech by Samdech Norodom Sihanouk, head of state of Cambodia and chairman of the National United Front of Cambodia, at the banquet here this evening in honour of Ieng Sary, special envoy of the interior part of the Royal Government of National Union of Cambodia and the National United Front of Cambodia:

Your Excellency Respected Premier of the State Council of the People's Republic of China,

Your Excellencies respected national military and civil authorities of the People's Republic of China and Mesdames,

Dear Chinese friends.

Your Excellencies esteemed ambassadors of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, the Republic of South Vietnam and the Democratic Republic of Vietnam and Mesdames,

Your Excellency Esteemed General Mongkhunvilay and Madame,

Your Excellency Esteemed General O Chin-u, chief of General Staff of the Korean People's Army and leader of the Korean military delegation, and all the members of the Korean military delegation,

Your Excellencies esteemed Messrs ambassadors of the countries friendly to the Khmer people, and Mesdames,

Esteemed Messrs charges d'affaires and Messrs representatives of the countries and peoples friendly to the Khmer people, and Mesdames,

Dear friends, dear compatriots,

First of all, allow me to express my profound gratitude to His Excellency Premier Chou En-lai who, in spite of his very heavy duties of the state and his very numerous diplomatic obligations, has honoured us with his high presence at this banquet, thus once again testifying to his great and constant friendship for the Khmer people and to the militant solidarity and complete support of the People's Republic of China to our struggle of national liberation.

My cordial thanks also go to Their Excellencies the national military and civil authorities of the People's Republic of China, to all the Chinese, Korean, Vietnamese and Lactian brothers and sisters who have honoured us by taking part in this banquet as well as to all the foreign personages friendly to the Khmer people present here and to the distinguished representatives of the Chinese press and international press.

Your Excellencies and Mesdames, ladies and gentlemen, the purpose of this reception is to introduce to you an eminent member of the Khmer resistance Mr Ieng Sary who has arrived in Peking recently, a delegate sent by the NUFC, the RGNUC and the PAFNLO (National United Front, the Royal Government of National Union and the People's Armed Forces of National Liberation of Cambodia) to the head of state, the prime minister of the RGNUC and the Political Burgau of the NUFC to bear testimony to the unbreakable union, indestructible unity and total solidarity of all the resistants who can be found within our country. Cambodia, with the Khmer resistants who must accomplish a mission outside of the country.

Certain foreigners in the world have tried and are still trying to make the international opinion believe that the Khmer resistance at home and the Khmer resistance abroad are two different movements. They have also insinuated that the NUFC and the RGNUC abroad are in reality nothing but a "group" of Khmers "in exile" and "uprooted" from the soil of their fatherland with which they no longer have any political ties and still less administrative ties.

In the speech which he will make presently, Mr Ieng Sary will acquaint you with the true situation of our united front and our government which are not and will never be divided into "NUFC and RGNUC at home" and "NUFC and RGNUC abroad."

Our NUFC and our RGNUC are "one". There are only Khmers who have the mission of waging the struggle for national salvation inside the country and other members of the NUFC and the RGNUC who have accepted from the people the task of fulfilling a mission over a certain period of time outside the country.

Moreover, I must point out that certain international circles seek to separate the Khmer communists from the other non-communist resistants. In this regard, it is appropriate to make it clear that my nationalist, progressive and Marxist compatriots who are carrying on resistance have decided of one accord to reject all ideological distinction or differences between them. They are and will be none other than members of the NUFC.

This is not a Utopian amalgamation, but corresponds strictly to the reality of our united fromt. In effect, the political programme of the NUFC which governs and will govern the political, administrative, social, cultural, economic, religious and diplomatic life of the Khmer mation during the present struggle and after liberation has been worked out together and adopted unanimously by the qualified representatives of the resistants of all socio-ideological tendencies who, finally, are alike in the sense that they are above all Khmers, and then legitimist, progressive, neutralist and anti-imperialist patriots.

Love of legitimacy (constitution of 1947, constitutional kingdom, people's democracy, that is to say, those which draw their legitimacy and reality from the people, the masses of the people of whom the peasants and workers constitute the pure symbols, and not fascist "democracy" and anti-popular "republic" which is "legitimatized" by a putsch), love of the national ideals of progress, neutrality, independence without compromise and comsequently anti-imperialism characterize and firmly unite, in fact, all the members of the NUFC, the RGNUC and the PAFNLC.

With regard to the solution of the problem of restoring peace to Cambodia, the following is the unshakable position of the NUFC and the RGNUC, that is to say, of the Khmer people and their representatives both inside and outside the country:

The putschists who have usurped state power in Phnom Penh since March 18, 1970 must completely remove themselves from that power and let the Khmer state return to its constitution of 1947. Since these traitors refuse to come to such a logical solution, they will be swept away by the armed struggle of the Khmer people represented by the NUFC, the RGNUC and the PAFFIC.

U.S. imperialism which has committed aggression against the independent and neutral Kingdom of Cambodia and has used the most odious means to neo-colonize our country must withdraw totally from Cambodia and withdraw quickly, unconditionally and totally from Cambodia its military personnel and all the non-Khmer armed forces (ground, air and sea) in its pay. Otherwise, the NUFC, the RGNUC and the PAFNLC, side by side with the fraternal peoples of Vietnam and Laos and having China as our vast reliable rear area, will fight unflinchingly and without accepting compromise against U.S. imperialism and its puppets, until they are totally swept out of our Indochina.

If the USA wishes to conform to the aspirations of the Khmer people for peace, it should not talk about any "international conference" or "cease-fire in place". It must stop giving protection, and and assistance directly or through "intermediary persons or countries" to the anti-constitutional, anti-national and anti-popular regime of Lon Nol-Sirik Matak-Son Ngoc Thamh.

In any case, the USA must know that the NUFC and the RGNUC will never accept an international conference or a cease-fire "in place", still less a partition of Cambodia or a political compromise under the deceitful signboard of "national reconciliation" or "national coalition" with the traitors of Phnom Penh, despicable hirelings of U.S. imperialism without which their problem would not exist.

Finally, the USA must note this well: The Khmer people represented by the NUFC and the RGNUC will forever remain united with the Vietnamese people represented by the DRV and the NFL and the PRO of South Vietnam and the Laotian people represented by the Laotian Patriotic Front. The NUFC and the RGNUC are and will remain unswervingly loyal to the resolutions of the Summit Conference of the Three Indochinese Peoples dated April 25, 1970.

No event, no pressure and no international conference will ever succeed in changing our position as specified above, because we fight not for a lame peace and an incomplete national sovereignty but for the complete liberation of our Khmer fatherland and our Indochina and for a true peace, which will not be acceptable and durable unless U.S. imperialism is totally and irreversibly swept out of Indochina, without being able to camouflage itself in our countries behind the policy called "Vietnamization" or "Khmerization".

With the very powerful and firm support and the multifarious aid of the People's Republic of China to which we express once again our most profound and affectionate gratitude, with the no less firm support of the 28 reliable friendly countries of Asia, Africa, Latin America and Europe which have officially recognized the RGNUC, and with the sympathy of other peoples in the world, the Khmer people, their NUFC, their RGNUC and their PAFNLC are sure to win.

With these sentiments, I ask your permission to raise my glass and drink a toast with all my compatriots present here

Respected Samdech Penn Nouth, chairman of the Political Bureau of the Central Committee of the NUFC and prime minister of the Royal Government of National Union of Cambodia,

On behalf of the interior part of the Royal Government of National Union of Cambodia and on behalf of our valiant people and fighters who are waging with determination the heroic struggle against the American imperialist aggressors and their valets, I express my profound gratitude to the two samdeches for having condescended to preside over and organize this magnificent banquet. This is a great honour which the two samdeches have condescended to accord me on the occasion of my arrival from the forefront of the flight against American imperialist aggressors and their valets. This banquet is a vivid testimony, among other things, of the firm determination to struggle on the part of the two samdeches, the Political Bureau and the RGNUC steadfastly and closely united in the resolute struggle of our people and our fighers at home. This precious testimony will certainly give a new and immense encouragement to the heroic struggle of our people and the fighters of the people's Armed Forces of National Liberation of Cambodia.

On this happy occasion, allow me to express my profound and warm thanks to Your Excellency and to you all, distinguished guests, for the great honour and the concrete evidence of militant solidarity and militant and fraternal friendship as well as the sympathy that you have been so kind to show to our people and to our fighters of PAFNIC. Your high presence here is a precious encouragement to the struggle of our people and our fighters.

Respected Samdech Head of State and Neak Moneang,

Respected Samdech Penn Nouth and Madame,

Your Excellency respected Premier Mr Chou En-lai,

Excellencies, ladies and gentlemen and dear friends,

In the past year and more, in their heroic struggle for national liberation against the American imperialist aggressors and their valets, under the banner of the NUFC presided

over by Head of State Samdech Norodom Sihanouk, the valiant Khmer people have won brilliant victories of strategic significance in all fields. Eight tenths of the national territory with nearly 5 million inhabitants have been completely liberated. An entirely new people's power is born there with the mission of building a new life for the people of new Cambodia.

Proceeding from their initiative and offensive position, the fighters of our PAFNLC are now continuing without respite their attacks against the enemy who is compelled to entrench itself in Phnom Penh and some urban centres.

The victories which have been achieved underline the leaping development of the Khmer revolution. The PAFNLC have developed rapidly by leaps and bounds to a very high level in the fight, both in quantity and quality, both from the viewpoint of political consciousness and from the viewpoint of combat technique. The three kinds of armed forces—guerrillas, regional forces and regular forces—are most closely linked among themselves, fighting the enemy on several fronts, wiping them out in very large numbers and mastering the situation completely.

The enemy's bitter military defeats during the last dry season have plunged the American imperialists and their valets Lon Nol-Sirik Matak-Son Ngoc Thanh into a still deeper impasse and thrown them into a still more untenable political situation. Not only are they not able to realize their plan for reassembling the population in the strategic hamlets and for recruiting them by force into their puppet army, but on the contrary, they are politically isolated to a very high degree inside as well as outside Cambodia. The clique of valets Lon Nol-Sirik Matak-Son Ngoc Thanh are tearing each other to pieces and slaughtering each other. The defeats of the American imperialists and their running dogs in Cambodia and in Indochina during the last dry season have been glaring.

However, by their aggressive and obdurate nature, the American imperialists and their valets of Saigon and Phnom Penh are not willing to admit their pitter defeats. At present, they are engineering in all fields, everywhere and in all forms, manoeuvres for realizing their criminal designs aimed at continuing their aggression against Cambodia and at subjugating the Khmer people. In the military field, they have made preparations to launch attacks against our liberated zone. In the political and diplomatic fields, the American imperialists have ordered their valets and accomplices to engineer manoeuvres aimed at resolving the Khmer problem by negotiation or by a compromise so as to gain a moment's respite and to deceive the Khmer people and international opinion. In doing so they want to wash their blood-stained hands. Equally, the puppets of Phnom Penh are playing a pernicious comedy with a view to creating a. "constitution" and staging "elections" in order to try to make the Khmer people and international opinion believe that their fascist regime is placed on legal bases and emanates from the people's will. All these subversive manoeuvres are aimed at sowing discord within the NUFC.

Educated by a long and rich tradition of struggle for the defence of their fundamental national rights, the heroic Khmer people have resolutely shattered one after another all the perfidious manoeuvres of the American imperialists, their valets and their accomplices.

Filled with determination and closing their ranks in the relentless attacks against the enemy without retreat and without accepting any compromise, the Khmer people and their valiant PAFNLC will continue to launch offensives to deal still heavier blows at the aggressors until complete victory.

For national salvation, there is but one and unique road: This is a revolutionary war under the banner of the NUFC. Between the patriots and traitors, the line of demarcation is very clear. All the patriots have rallied themselves around the NUFC: All the traitors have taken the side of the American imperialists and the Lon Nol-Sirik Matak-Son Ngoc Thanh puppet clique. The search for a third force or of a solution of compromise is nothing but illusion and will only bring to their authors bitterness, shame and bloodshed. As firmly emphasized by Head of State Samdech Norodom Sihanouk, "the NUFC and the RGNUC will never accept an international conference or a cease-fire 'in place', still less a partition of Cambodia or a political compromise under the deceitful signboard of 'national reconciliation' or 'national coalition' with the traitors of Phnom Penh", valets of the American imperialists.

Our people and fighters possess a very clear view on these problems. That is why, surmounting all kinds of difficulties and making all sacrifices, at present as well as in the future, demanded by the revolutionary war of national and people's liberation, the valiant Khmer people and their valiant fighters will develop still further their revolutionary heroism, strengthen their determination to fight and continue to launch offensives against the enemy to smash the aggression of the American imperialists and their Saigon puppets, to overthrow the regime of the Lon Nol-Sirik Matak-Son Ngoc Thanh traitorous clique, to liberate completely the sacred national territory and to build a new, independent, sovereign, neutral, peaceful, democratic and prosperous Cambodia in its territorial integrity.

The essential reasons for the victories of our people are twofold.

The first essential reason is that the NUFC, which has widely and solidly united all the patriotic classes and social strata of the country on the basis of worker-peasant alliance, has a correct and wise leadership, conforms to a correct political line, and relies on the heroic PAFNLC. Taught by their own experience acquired at the price of blood and sweat, our people have decided to firmly apply the slogans: "independence, be the master of the situation, be the master of the soil, rely on one's own efforts, be determined to take the national destiny into the hand".

In my capacity as special envoy of the interior part of the RGNUC, of our people and our fighters, I have the pride and joy to emphasize before Your Excellencies, before you, ladies and gentlemen and dear friends, the complete identity of views in the conception, position and attitude towards all the above-mentioned problems among the resistants of the NUFC and the RGNUC both inside and outside the country, from the two samdeches down to all the Khmer fighters and people.

The complete identity of views on the direction of the revolutionary war of national and people's liberation and on the building of a new Cambodia constitutes a very powerful factor for the present struggle of our people till total victory.

Our valiant people and valiant fighters respectfully admire the great patriotism and the most resolute determination which animate at all times Samdech Norodom Sihancuk, head of state and chairman of the NUFC, and Samdech Penn Nouth, chairman of the Political Bureau and Prime Minister of the RGNUC. The two samdeches have raised very high the banner of national independence and struggle against the American imperialists and their valets. The two samdeches have worked with vigour to contribute effectively to the revolutionary war of the Khmer people. The Khmer people recognize only Samdech Norodom Sihancuk as the head of state of Cambodia. The Khmer people recognize only the RGNUC with Samdech Penn Nouth as the prime minister and Mr. Khieu Samphan as the deputy prime minister. The RGNUC is the sole and unique legal and legitimate government of Cambodia.

The 18 January 1971 appeal of Samdech Norodom Sihanouk, Samdech Penn Nouth, the Political Bureau and the RGNUC is a powerful echo of the historic declaration of Samdech Norodom Sihanouk dated 23 March 1970 and is a stout crystallization of the determination of the Khmer people to fight.

Another reason for our victories is our powerful and very firm militant solidarity with the heroic fraternal peoples of Viet Nam and Laos on the basis of the joint declaration of the Summit Conference of the Indochinese Peoples. The Knmer people are determined to develop this militant solidarity, shoulder to shoulder, against our common enemies the American imperialists. This militant solidarity is being strengthened with each passing day and has gone through all kinds of tests.

The glorious People's Republic of China and the great Chinese people have contributed powerfully to our struggle as our vast rear area and a very reliable support base. The militant and fraternal solidarity and friendship between the peoples of Cambodia and China are manifested in the stirring facts of the struggle against their common enemies the American imperialists. The great Chairman Mao, the Chinese Government and the heroic Chinese people have given our struggle immense and effective support and assistance in all fields and in all forms, moral, political and material. Such assistance of the People's Republic of China is [a] very important factor in the victory of our struggle.

The heroic Korean people and the Government of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea headed by Marshal Kim Il-song have also extended important and multifarious support and assistance to our struggle.

The great militant solidarity of the revolutionary peoples of Cambodia, China, Vietnam, Laos and Korea is a concrete reality of the Asia of today and will completely repel the aggression by the American imperialists. The anti-imperialist front of the five Asian countries is being strengthened with each passing day as demanded by the struggle against the American imperialists and the Japanese militarists.

In their fight, the Khmer people have equally benefitted from the aid and support given by the governments of other friendly countries. The governments and peoples of these friendly anti-imperialist countries resolutely stand on the side of the Khmer people in recognizing the RGNUC as the sole and unique legal and legitimate Government of Cambodia.
