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RONUC 22 MARCH STATEMENT ON NUFC-CPNIAP ANNIVERSARY

[22 March RONGUC statement on NUFC-PNIAP anniversary]

[Text] Cambodia, 25 March, AKI--March 23, 1975 marks the fifth anniversary of the founding of the NUFC and the CPNIAP. In over 5 years of obstinate and resolute struggle against the U. S. imperialist aggression and the Phnom Penh traitors, the NUFC and CPNIAP have successively checked all enemy military operations and maneuvers.

HISTORY OF THE VIETNAM WAR ON MICROFILM

Today they have liberated 97 percent of the national territory and 6 million inhabitants. The NUPC and CPNLAF represent the profound aspirations of the entire Cambodian people with the exception of a handful of traitors--instruments of the U.S. imperialist neocolonialism in Cambodia. The RGNUC has the qualifications and assumes the responsibilities of the independent, sovereign, neutral, nonaligned and democratic Cambodian state which has been established in the vast liberated zone and has diplomatic relations with more than 60 sovereign states.

At present under the violent and ceaseless attacks by the people and their CPNLAF, the handful of Phnom Penh traitors is facing a desperate situation. Everyone agrees that their inevitable end is near.

But despite the opposition of the U.S. people, personalities and peace- and justice-loving peoples throughout the world, the Ford-Kissinger administration is persisting in its intervention in Cambodia, intensifying the airlift and using lies and subterfuges to continue to help the Phnom Penh traitors. Moreover, it sent 7th Fleet warships, including the helicopter carrier Okinawa with several thousand Marines, to the Gulf of Thailand, ready to intervene in Cambodia at any moment.

Thus, instead of ending the U.S. imperialist aggression, the Ford-Kissinger administration is continuing to pursue the Cambodianization of the war and sow destruction and suffering in order to maintain U.S. colonialism in Cambodia.

On this solemn occasion of the fifth anniversary of the founding of the NUPC and CPNLAF, the RGNUC would like to reaffirm that the aim of the Cambodian people's and CPNLAF's struggle under the guidance of the NUPC is the reestablishment of an independent, sovereign, peaceful, neutral and nonaligned Cambodia. In fact, the Cambodian people and CPNLAF are determined to continue their just struggle until the cessation of all direct or indirect U.S. imperialist interventions. The frenzied pursuit of intervention by the Ford-Kissinger administration and its aid and obstinate support for the traitorous Phnom Penh clique cannot prevent the Cambodian people, their CPNLAF, NUPC and RGNUC from ending, at any cost, the existence of the traitors, and all this is reinforcing their determination to pursue their just struggle without compromise or retreat until the complete realization of five points of the 23 March 1970 statement by Samdech Norodom Sihanouk, chief of state and chairman of the NUPC. Cambodia's affairs must be settled without foreign interference, by people themselves--whose sole and legitimate representative is the RGNUC with Samdech Penn Nouth as prime minister and Mr Khieu Samphan as deputy prime minister. Embracing all the patriotic forces of the nation which have their representatives in its ranks, the RGNUC has, during the past 5 years of struggle, displayed maturity and full qualifications for successfully administering all state affairs.

The war in Cambodia will cease and true peace will be restored after all interventions by the Ford-Kissinger administration have stopped. Cambodia's affairs will be solved by the RGNUC in conformity with the decisions of the second national congress. All members of military and semimilitary organizations at the service of the traitorous Phnom Penh regime must lay down their weapons and surrender to the CPNLAF. With the exception of the handful of Phnom Penh traitors, each citizen will have his place in the national community to build an independent, sovereign, peaceful, neutral, nonaligned, democratic and prosperous Cambodia.

The RGNUC reaffirms that it will always stick to a domestic policy of broad national unity without distinction of social classes, political tendencies or religious beliefs and regardless of the past of each citizen, except for the handful of Phnom Penh traitors.

Concerning its foreign policy, the RGNUC reaffirms its pursuance of a neutral and nonaligned policy and will firmly adhere to the five principles of peaceful coexistence in its relations with all other countries, near or far, without distinction of political and social systems and on the basis of the principles of equality, mutual respect, reciprocal interest, nonaggression and noninterference in the internal affairs of others.

The Cambodian people and their NUFC, RGNUC and CPNLAP once again warmly thank all the friendly governments and countries, the peace- and justice-loving people in the United States and throughout the world and all national and international democratic organizations for their aid and support to the just struggle for national liberation, and believe that this aid and support will continuously increase until complete victory.

In order to reduce the sufferings and misfortunes of the Cambodian nation and people and to restore true and lasting peace in Cambodia as soon as possible, the RGNUC appeals to all members of military and semimilitary organizations of the traitorous Phnom Penh regime to abandon their ranks and turn their weapons against the traitors. The RGNUC appeals to people of all social classes and strata in the enclaves temporarily controlled by the enemy to unite and conduct a manifold fight against the traitors' gang to annihilate it. Let the entire Cambodian people, closely united with the CPNLAP, at the frontline as well as in the rear, in the liberated zone as well as in the enclaves temporarily controlled by the enemy, redouble their combativeness and intensify their struggle against the U.S. imperialist aggressors and their lackeys--the Phnom Penh traitors--in order to completely liberate the Cambodian nation and people forever!

BANGKOK PAPER REPORTS ASIAN PRESSURE FOR LON NOL RESIGNATION

[Text] Four Asian embassies in Phnom Penh will temporarily close down over the next 2 weeks in a move to pressure President Lon Nol to resign and leave Cambodia immediately. They are the Thai, Japanese, Malaysian and Indonesian embassies. They are being led by Japan. The embassies of the United States, South Korea, Taiwan and South Vietnam will remain open.

According to sources, the Thai Embassy staff will leave Phnom Penh by a Royal Thai Air Force C-123 and arrive in Bangkok on Tuesday. Personnel of the other three embassies will stay if Lon Nol resigns prior to their scheduled departures.

NUFC RADIO NOTES EXODUS OF DIPLOMATS FROM PHNOM PENH

[Excerpts] All foreign embassies in Phnom Penh, with the exception of those of the U.S. imperialists and some of their puppets, have abandoned the traitors. According to the latest report from Phnom Penh, on 19 and 20 March embassy personnel, including the ambassadors of the Philippines and Great Britain, left Phnom Penh. One after another, embassy personnel--including the ambassadors and heads of the diplomatic missions of France, Japan, Australia, Singapore, Thailand, the Philippines, Britain and so on--have evacuated Phnom Penh. Most of the embassies have now closed their doors, and others keep on only a few guards.

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In the U.S. Embassy, Dean and the U.S. military advisers have not yet moved out because they continue to carry on their policy of aggression and interference in Cambodia. However, Dean ordered his men to hastily burn secret documents for fear that our CPNLAP might capture them when we take Phnom Penh. The closure of almost all of foreign embassies in Phnom Penh has further isolated the seven traitors and driven them into greater panic. Their doom-day is not far off.

DEMONSTRATIONS AGAINST NEW LON NOL CABINET REPORTED

[Text] On 21 March, Dean ordered traitor Lon Nol to announce the composition of the so-called "government" of traitor Long Boret. This is the third time that U.S. imperialism has instigated Long Boret to head a so-called "cabinet" of this traitorous republic, which has no land, rice, people, or money.

Upon learning of the formation of this new traitorous government, monks, people, workers, youths, students, teachers, functionaries and soldiers immediately rejected it, for it is nothing new. The so-called "new Long Boret government" is in fact essentially the same old instrument of U.S. imperialist neocolonialism represented by the seven archantidomestic, archdecadent and archfascist traitors. For a week Dean worked hard to produce the same old tottering, traitorous, corrupt and incapable government. Since then monks, people, workers, youths, students, teachers, functionaries and soldiers have risen up in violent riots. On 18, 19, 20 and 21 March, when Lon Nol announced his new traitorous government, one demonstration after another erupted in Phnom Penh. The demonstrators categorically rejected the seven traitors Lon Nol, Sirik Matak, Son Ngoc Thanh, Cheng Heng, In Tam, Long Boret and Sosthene Fernandez and denounced the Ford administration for continuing to furnish aid to the Phnom Penh traitors. They flatly demanded that U.S. imperialism cease its aid which can only prolong the war of aggression of the U.S. imperialists and their lackeys.

This third Long Boret government, like the first and second, is nothing but a U.S. instrument to continue its war of aggression. The people are determined to join the CPNLAP and NUFC in annihilating the seven traitors and driving all U.S. imperialists from Cambodia. All fraternal politicians, personalities and soldiers who are serving in various organizations of the traitorous regime should know, as the second national congress has already stressed, that the main condition to be pardoned by the Cambodian nation and people is that they must abandon the seven traitors. Their only hope for survival is to rally to the NUFC and eliminate the U.S. imperialists as well as the seven traitors.
