# RVN SPOKESMAN AGAIN DENIES ARVN TROOPS IN CAMBODIA

[Text] Saigon 20 August (VP)--The government spokesman this morning termed "unfounded" the charges by Sihanouk on Friday and by Vo Dong Giang on Saturday that the RVN had sent troops to Cambodia. According to the government spokesman, Vo Dong Giang himself had to admit later he could not cite any clear evidence.

At a press briefing at the public information center, Mr Bui Bao Truc said Sihanouk and Vo Dong Giang had made similar statements because they are "birds of the same feather." The government spokesman pointed out that Sihanouk has lived in exile in Peking or Moscow, and Vo Dong Giang once admitted that he belongs to an organization called a "government" without a capital.

Commenting on a threat implied in Sihanouk's statement that North Vietnam would launch a new offensive, the spokesman said: If the North Vietnamese communists embark on a new adventure, they would be defeated tragically, as they were last summer. Mr Bui Bao Truc recalled a U.S. commitment whereby the bombing of North Vietnam would be resumed if North Vietnam launched a new offensive against South Vietnam.
