SUBJ: (C) VC/NVA Attitude Towards New Developments in Cambodia.

(C) 3 pages, reproduction; B-6) Directive, dated 31 Mar 70, originated by the Current Affairs Committee of Long An ((possibly Daklak Province Party Committee, B3 Front)), addressed to all subordinate districts and units, concerns friendly ((VC/NVA)) attitudes toward new developments in Cambodia. The directive contains an outline of events which took place in Cambodia since the two embassies ((VC and NVN)) were attacked by Cambodian demonstrators on 11 and 12 Mar 70.

The directive notes that the current policy ((of VC/NVN)) towards Cambodia consisted of (1) full support of the five-point statement issued by Prince Norodom Sihanouk on 23 Mar 70; (2) efforts to strengthen solidarity between the Vietnamese and Cambodian peoples; (3) the avoidance of any "decisive clashes" with the new regime; (4) a steadfast determination to completely destroy "them" ((elements of the Cambodian Army)), if ever provoked by them; and (5) positive assistance to the ((Cambodian)) population and readiness to fulfill the "international task."

Addressees were also instructed to carefully gather information pertaining to the enemy ((meaning Cambodian Army)) at the border, and to forward this information to Long An without delay. Transportation elements moving from BT4 ((possibly Military Station 4)) to BT Nam ((possibly Southern Military Station)) should be instructed to take extreme caution to avoid all enemy attempts to provoke or capture ((VC/NVA personnel)). In conjunction, measures should be taken to shatter any "plots" of the US and to provide adequate support to the ((Cambodian)) revolutionary forces.
