15. SUMMARY:	
<p>(C) This report contains information obtained from an enemy document captured on 24 May 1970, and concerns an undated entry in a notebook which reveals that on 30 ((possibly June 1969)) a VC/NVA delegation was greeted by Premier Lon Nol upon their arrival in Phnom Penh. The purpose of the visit was to enhance the VC/NVA government's prestige. The document further reveals the events that occurred during the next few days. Other translated entries in the notebook pertain to reports on security missions.</p>

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On the night of 21 Jun ((69)) Comrade Ba Hue reported on the security missions. Sixty-one ((suspected)) cases of theft were reported, five of which were investigated. It was requested that the other cases be investigated.

Eighteen cases of illicit relations ((with the opposite sex)) were reported, involving (eight men and eight ((Women's)) Association ((members))), and ((two)) "Chien" ((possibly soldiers)).

More than 20 attempts of desertion were reported, 10 ((men)) actually deserted. Five of those who made the attempt were punished.

Loss: 35,460 Riels ((55R = \$1.00 US)) and 300 \$((SVN)) ((118 \$ SVN = \$1.00 US)).

Loss: 6,839 Riels (personal money).

Loss: Two bicycles, two watches, two hammocks, etc... ((sic)).

Much progress has been made ((in the security task)) as compared with Oct 68.

Three men fired their weapons in an indiscriminate manner. A report of it was made.

The political and ideological indoctrination task was not performed properly; as a result, a number of individuals such as "Chau" ((nephew of)) H and Muoi Chan must be reindoctrinated.

A DELEGATION OF OUR GOVERNMENT TO CAMBODIA

The purpose of this delegation was to enhance our government's prestige. Cambodia is a neutral country where there are many foreign embassies - Saigon - Phnom Penh. ((possibly meaning - Phnom Penh is the capital of Cambodia like Saigon is that of SVN)). Huynh Tan Phat, includes 15 persons ((possibly meaning: The delegation included 15 persons and was headed by Huynh Tan Phat)).

The delegation crossed the border on 29 ((month and year unspecified)), then rested. On the morning of the 30th they arrived in Phnom Penh by plane.

Premier Lon Nol met the delegation. Two Dakota planes and two helicopters escorted by two fighters were sent to pick up the visiting delegation. The airfield was decorated with flags and red carpets. Upon the arrival of the delegation, there was a SVN airliner on a runway. It was told to take off at once.

Acting Premier Lon Nol led the reception committee. After the inspection of the honor guard and the salute to the flags in which the Vietnamese flag was presented first, the delegation delivered a speech in Vietnamese that was translated into French.

Afterward, the delegation was led to the ((Cambodian)) palace where they stayed as guests. Our chairman was given three rooms, Duong Huynh Hoa was given two, and the rest were given one room each. Every room was comfortable and all necessities were provided, including fruit, toothbrushes, and toothpaste.

In the afternoon, the DRV Ambassador called on the delegation formally. In the evening Sihanouk gave a royal banquet ((in their honor)).

Representatives of the Yugoslavian, Indonesian, and Arabian Embassies were also present at the reception. After the introductions, Mr. Phat and Sihanouk talked like two brothers who had met each other after a long separation. Duong Quynh Hoa was introduced as the son of Professor ((blank on O.T.)). Sihanouk introduced his ministers who have had schooling in Saigon and Hanoi. Then, after granting the highest medal of his kingdom to Mr. Phat, Sihanouk urged all persons present to congratulate him. Our delegation gave him, in return, a painting with his portrait on it. Sihanouk stated that the portrait was better looking than he was. That made the Cambodian ministers, vice-ministers, and high ranking officials have a good impression of us.

On 1 Jul, our delegation called on the Cambodian Queen. The duration of the visit was set for 15 minutes, but the Queen talked with the delegation for 30

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minutes. During the course of this visit, our delegation pointed out our success and the schemes of the US that had failed; but the US tenaciously continued its neo-colonialism. Sihanouk thanked the delegation for revealing this to him. He said that he was ignorant of this matter. Afterwards, the delegation was invited to dine with Sihanouk.

Next, our delegation called on our embassy ((referring to that of the DRV)). The reception was elaborately organized. Many Vietnamese residents were present to welcome our delegates.

That evening, the ((Cambodian)) Chief of State organized a show for the delegation's honor. The show began with two Vietnamese songs entitled: "Vietnamese March" and "Sewing Clothes". There were 1,300 participants.

Afterward, our delegation organized a reception for four ((Cambodian)) VIP's.

On 2 Jul, the delegation visited Sang Kum University, then went by plane and visited Battambang Province where they were received and led to the ((Cambodian)) Government Palace by the Colonel, Chief of the Province. That afternoon, they visited the museum.

On 3 Jul, they visited a textile plant, then the Port of Sihanoukville on 4 Jul. This port has been built on the coast of the Gulf of Thailand because of the US and Diem. Our delegation wrote in the guest book of the port and praised its economic developments and its self-reliance. Then they visited the railroad station and went by train to visit a petroleum refining plant.

On 4 Jul we returned to the palace. The Chinese Ambassador visited us and informed us of our victories and the US schemes.

At night, we gave a banquet to 70 persons including 14 high ranking cadre and officers of Sihanouk. The atmosphere was as intimate as it was at the national feast. ((Sihanouk)) granted medals to our whole group in the tea house, then guided us to the warehouse. The gift he presented to us was worth 5,000,000 Riels. At 2200 hours, he invited us to his residence to watch movies until 0100 hours. The movie was filmed at the Anghor Temple and was written by Sihanouk. He and his wife took the lead parts. His wife played the spy and he acted as an intelligence officer.

When our group returned, he watched us leave. Consequently, he had to change the program of the ceremony he had planned to hold.

To return our visit, he came to the SVN Embassy.

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Mr. Phat sat in the middle and Chief of State Sihanouk and Prime Minister Lon Nol sat on the two sides.

Afterwards, the Chief of State guided Mr. Huynh on a visit to the ((Vietnamese)) residents.

In this reception, the people waved two banners and shouted hurrah to greet them. This was more solemn than the previous visit.

Our visit ((to Cambodia)) this time was considered a success because the local newspapers have not made any criticisms.

The Japanese, French, English, and Cambodian television men arrived and gave the films they had made to our cameramen and Vietnamese pressmen as a souvenir prior to our trip back.

Comrade Hai B ((possibly Bac)) Security Mission of Doi ((Unit)) 3

The enemy conducted intense bombing attacks.

The "A" ((possibly Cambodian)) forces have undergone a complete change and are ready for combat. They have full information on our bivouac sites, our commanders, and the location of every one of our units.

A captain, ((possibly Cambodian)), wanted to see Ba Son. He entered our area to see our comrades but Ba Son refused to meet him.

One A squad ((possibly Cambodian)) set up an ambush and encircled ((our)) dispensary on (7 Jul) ((possibly 69)).

8 Jul ((possibly 69)): One hundred men ((possibly Cambodian intelligence agents)) entered Lien Co to identify ((these who are pro-VC among the people)).

((Cambodian)) public security and intelligence agents disguised themselves as merchants.

5 Aug ((possibly 69)): ((Unit)) A2 spread the news that two ((possibly Cambodians)) entered the dispensary area.

"Xep" ((possibly corporal first class)) Suat said artillery fire would be delivered into our bivouac site for us to see what artillery fire was ((sic)).

((Security)) measures: When moving, we should not go alone but be accompanied by another comrade.

When the "C Fu" ((possibly Revolutionary Provisional Government officials)) had arrived and signed "something" ((possibly an agreement)), 40 N ((possibly)) men were returned ((possibly by the Cambodian Government to the VC)).

When moving around we must carry our papers ((possibly ID Cards)) along with us in case we are questioned by ((the police)).

((Unit)) B20, along with a number of A ((squads)) of ((Unit)) B19, must conduct administrative and inspection activities.

In our bivouac areas, we must keep watch on passengers on roads, strangers, etc... ((sic)).

In case it is discovered, ((Unit)) A8 must ((hide)) in the people's hamlet.

- Doi ((Unit)) 3 has been informed in advance of places to hide to avoid ((possibly searches by Cambodian troops)).

Doi 3 will give a warning of the coming of "A" ((possibly Cambodian troops)) so that measures can be taken to cope with them.

When going to markets, adjutants must carry papers with them. We must go there ((sic)) to transport corn ((one word illegible)).

"A" ((possibly Cambodian)) authorities opposed our cutting of trees.

Those civilians who do not have papers ((possibly written authorizations)) are not allowed to move along our corridors.

It is forbidden to buy cattle.

We must stand guard against armed "A" ((Cambodians)). We are not to receive them even though they are "red" ((possibly meaning Communist)).
