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Commentary on Phnom Penh Collapse

[Commentary: "The Sending in of Saigen Puppet Treops Cannot Save the U.S. Lackeys in Phnom Penh From an Inevitable Collapse"]

[Text] After releasing a lot of vague information about U.S. countermeasures in the face of recent events in Cambodia, the Nixon administration has sent in the Saigon puppet troops to save the Lon Nol clique which is dying inside the ever-tightening noose of the CPNLAF. According to Western sources, on 15 April (?thousands of Saigon Rangers) with the support of tanks and armored cars formed two spearheads advancing into Cambodian territory. One spearhead advanced through Tan Chau and Hong Ngu towns about 150 kms west of Saigon and the other advanced in the direction of Tinh Bien 50 kms southwest of Hong Ngu. The aforementioned sources observed that this was the second biggest operation conducted by the Saigon armed forces since the cease-fire order went into force on 28 January 1973.

Obviously, this is the result of the recent sudden trip of General Haig, U.S. Army deputy chief of staff and special envoy of U.S. President Nixon, to Bangkok, Phnom Penh, Saigon, and Vientiane. He went to study the current situation in Cambodia on the spot, or to speak more realistically, to study measures which the Nixon administration (?can) apply to save its lackeys in Phnom Penh.

The sending in of Saigon puppet troops to save the Lon Nol clique is a (?very dangerous) new act of war escalation by the U.S. imperialists in the wake of other (?extremist) activities such as the (?constant pouring) of armaments, munitions, and other war materiel through an airlift from U.S. bases in Thailand to assist the Phnom Penh puppet administration in continuing to massacre the Cambodian people, and the repeated sending of aircraft—especially strategic B-52's and swing—wing F-111's—to intensively, day and night, bomb and attack many populous areas in Cambodia in a destructive manner. These destructive bombardments have been taking place continuously for more than the past month at an ever-increasing rate of violence, with the sorties of aircraft increasing from 40 to 160, and at the present time to 220 each day.

Even AP had to admit (?at one point) that the entire force of bombers that could be mustered in Southeast Asia, including B-52's and F-III's, had been mobilized to attack the Cambodian people in a widespread air blitz that seemed to surpass the tactical support for ground forces—meaning the Lon Nol puppet army. AP also quoted many (?reliable sources) as saying that this is a most violent bombing campaign that can be compared with the U.S. Air Force raids on the Hanoi and Haiphong areas in late 1972.

On 13 April the White House spokesman openly declared that the United States would continue the bombing in Cambodia and continue to send supplies to the Phnom Penh puppet administration. Together with such (every warlike) statements, the fact that the Nixon administration has blatantly sent Saigon puppet troops to invade Cambodia has completely shattered the slanderous themes and distortions directed by the United States and its lackeys against the DRV and the PRGRSV. This act clearly indicates that the United States itself is the one who has crudely infringed on the independence, sovereignty, unity, territorial integrity and neutrality of Cambodia and has violated in an extremely blatant manner the Paris agreement on Vietnam and the act of the international conference on Vietnam.

This grave act of war escalation by the United States is an insolent challenge to the Indochinese people and to progressive public opinion in the United States and in the world. It will only fan higher the fire of hatred harbored in the hearts of the Cambodian people for the clique of country robbers and sellers. Frenzied and (?stupefied), the U.S. imperialists and their lackeys have further proved that they are in a critical situation and that their failure is inevitable in the face of the outstanding growth of the Cambodian revolution. In addition, this has further exposed the U.S. administration's stubbornness and bellicosity in continuing to rush headlong in trying to impose U.S. neocolonialism on Cambodia, thus getting the United States further involved in the criminal war of aggression waged by the U.S. imperialists against foreign countries.

The fact that the Saigon administration, on U.S. orders, has sent its troops to invade Cambodia has further exposed its nature as an efficient U.S. lackey and a tool to serve the Nixon doctrine in Indochina, as well as its willingness to cheaply sell the blood and bones of southern (?youths) to the U.S. monopolist capitalist clique.

The U.S. imperialists and their lackeys must remember the lesson that cost them dearly in terms of human lives 3 years ago. Although provided with U.S. air and artillery support, the large-scale military advanture of more than 100,000 U.S.-Saigon puppet troops into Cambodian territory to save the Lon Nol-Sirik Matak clique was badly foiled by the Cambodian armed forces and people, and finally the enemy had to pack up and get out of Cambodia after sustaining disastrous failures (?in termsof human lives as well as in) [passage indistinct].

By sending Saigon troops in invade Cambodia along with [words indistinct] in this land and continuing to channel weapons, ammunition, and other war material to the Phnom Penh puppet clique, the U.S. imperialists can only prolong the agony of the countryselling puppet Lon Nol clique, but will certainly fail to prevent the inevitable collapse of a reactionary puppet regime—a political corpse which has been dumped into a (?garbage container) by history.

The explosions of the bombs that a patriotic officer recently dropped on the Lon Nol clique's residence testify to the grave predicament of the Americans' puppet and lackey regime in Phnom Penh.

Our armed forces and people are extremely enthusiastic over and proud of the heroic Cambodian armed forces and people's victories of great strategic significance. These victories have contributed very significantly to creating a general situation very favorable to the revolutionary struggle of the peoples of the three countries of Indochina. We are sincerely grateful to the fraternal Cambodian armed forces and people, who have wholeheartedly helped and encouraged our Vietnamese people in their anti-U.S. national salvation struggle.

The United States must fully respect the Cambodian people's fundamental national rights and respect Cambodia's neutrality. The internal affairs of Cambodian must be settled by the Cambodian people without foreign interference. The Cambodian armed forces and people, under NUFC-RGNUC leadership, are persevering in and intensifying their struggle against the Americans and their lackeys with a view to building an independent, sovereign, peaceful, neutral, democratic and prosperous Cambodia with territorial integrity.
