## PRINCE SIHANOUK ACCUSED THE U.S. OF PROTECTING THE REACTIONARY CLIQUE "KHMER SEREI" IN ACTIVITY IN SOUTH-VIETNAM

On November 5, Radio Phnom-Penh broadcast the statement of Prince Sibanouk, Chief of State of Cambodia, denouncing that the "Khmer Serel" clique continues to carry out their anti-Cambodian activities in South Vietnam after Ngo-dinh-Diem has been overthrown.
