PRINCE SIHANOUK CABLES VIETNAM LEADER

Peking NCNA International Service in English 1935 GMT 16 March 1967--W

(Text) Phnom Penh, 16 March--Samdech Sihanouk, Cambodian chief of state, has cabled his thanks to Ton Duc Thang, president of the Presidium of the Central Committee of the Vietnam Fatherland Front, for his message of greetings on the occasion of the second anniversary--1 March--of the Indochinese People's Conference and for his reaffirmation of support to the Cambodian people, according to the Cambodian news agency today.

In his cable, Samdech Sihanouk said: "The Indochinese People's Conference will go down in history as the first concrete manifestation of the natural solidarity linking the Cambodian, Laotian, and Vietnamese people in their struggle against imperialist aggression. What is most inspiring is that in spite of the increasingly savage attacks, the threats and schemes by the Americans and their Asian and other accomplices, this solidarity in Indochina has been steadily strengthened."

Samdech Sihanouk expressed full support for the "just struggle to resist the U.S. aggressors by the valiant and fraternal Vietnamese people and the Vietnam Fatherland Front which represents the just aspiration of the Vietnamese people."

The cable stressed that the five-part statement of the NFLSV and the four-point stand of the DRV are the basis for restoring peace in Vietnam.
