CAMBODIA'S SIHANOUK ARRIVES FOR VISIT

Tirana Domestic Service in Albanian 1900 GMT 9 Dec 75 AU

[Summary] Samlech Norodom Sihanouk, chief of state and chairman of the NUFC, and his entourage arrived in our country today at the invitation of Haxhi Lleshi, chairman of the Presidium of the People's Assembly, and Mehmet Shehu, chairman of the Council of Ministers, for a friendly visit to the Albanian People's Republic.

Rinas Airport was decorated with flags of both countries and slogans welcoming the guests from Cambodia. Two large portraits of Comrade Enver Hoxha and Samdech Norodom Sihanouk were hung on the central building of the airport. He said that the fundamental principles of the talks were indivisibly linked with the mutual reduction of armed forces and arms in central Europe. This included the undiminished security of all participants, the mutual nature of the reductions and the equality of the obligations accepted. The proposals of the socialist states were also based on the principle that all participants undertake at the same time the obligation to reduce their ground and air forces, as well as their nuclear units.

Ambassador Ceser criticized the stand adopted by the NATO states to far. He said that in their negotiations the NATC states want to bypass the aims agreed upon. He called on them to respond at long last in a positive way to the realistic and accommodating initiatives by the socialist states.

NEW NATO MBFR PROPOSAL NOT 'APPROPRIATE'

[Excerpt | Brussels -- The new NATO proposal [for the withdrawal of U.S. and Soviet troops and arms from central Europe] is 'quite obviously disproportionate. The common platform mentioned by Genscher seeks to keep the armed forces of the two sides at the same strength. The socialist countries have already stated that this should not be considered the immediate objective of the Vienna force reduction talks.

The value of the proposal is further diminished by the fact that the missile delivery craft to be withdrawn include (?Nairn) and Pershing rockets and Phantom aircraft which are for the most part obsolescent weapons. The U.S. Congress is, however, pressing very firmly for a considerable reduction in the number of U.S. tactical nuclear weapons in Europe and has even reached a decision on this, though it is not final.

The inclusion of the nuclear element in the Vienna force reduction talks is, undoubtedly, a positive step. The socialist countries stressed earlier that this is necessary. The proposal made in Brussels, however, is far from being realistic and even if it marks a change in the former rigidly negative attitude, it is still not appropriate or fully acceptable. Yet this decision was a major step at last week's series of discussions by the NATO Ministerial Council.

In other respects the Atlantic alliance has not made any notable progress. The central theme of the talks was East-West relations after Helsinki. The members of the Atlantic alliance gave no sign of any serious desire to go shead in this field.

RUDE PRAVO CRITICIZES NEW NATO MBFR PROPOSAL

Prague RUDE PRAVO in Czech 15 Dec 75 p 5 AU

[Miroslav Kubin Bonn dispatch in the column "The World and the Times": "A 'Unique' Proposal"]

[Text] After the winter meeting of the NATO defense ministers, the NATO Ministerial Council -its members consist of the ministers of foreign affairs -- convened on Thursday and Friday in Brussels. From their session emerged what they themselves have called a "unique", never-to-be-repeated proposal. Allegedly this will provide the extraordinary opportunity to achieve progress in the Vienna negotiations on the reduction of the number of troops and armaments in central Europe. U.S. Secretary of State Kissinger formulated the proposal, according to which the number of American atomic warheads located in Western Europe (mostly on FRG territory) would be reduced by about 1,000. Presently about 7,300 warheads are located there. Likewise, the withdrawal of about 29,000 of the 300,000 American soldiers from Western Europe would be considered.

According to the American conditions, in return for this "gesture" the USSR should practically liquidate one of its tank armies and reduce the number of troops in the appropriate are by 68,000 people. The Warsaw Pact states should allegedly accept the demand that the reduction of the number of troops in the second reduction phase to 700,000 men on each side of the reduction sphere concern the total number and not signify any reduction of the armies of individual states. This would reserve for NATO the right to maintain the numerical force of American troops and of the Bundeswehr and instead of reducing them, rather to reduce the number of British, Dutch and Belgian troops or to transfer them to Great Britain. Apart from that, the Warsaw Pact states should allegedly undertake the pledge that their troops would never be effectively stronger than the NATO troops. What role should then be played by the remaining 6,000 nuclear warheads on FRG territory -- that is not stated in the Kissinger proposal. However, NATO military circles claim that they cannot do without them, since otherwise their strategy of "flexible response" would allegedly be threatened. This strategy envisages, first, the deployment of conventional weapons, then of tactical nuclear weapons and finally of strategic nuclear weapons.

Of course, the "unique" nature of the Atlantic proposal loses its glamor, according to some observers here, because of a certain political shortcoming: Some time ago the U.S. Congress committed itself to reassessing the storing of the 7,000 nuclear warheads in question -- they are mostly obsolete -- by 1977 at the latest, so that their "permanent storage" is uncertain as it is. Apart from that, the broad public has been insisting for years that these weapons be removed from Western Europe.

It is possible to get an idea of the sincerity of Kissinger's "unique" proposal for instance from what the military-political commentary of the daily DIE WELT said: "The initiators of the new proposal categorically deny that this would substantially change the attitude of the West and that this would meet halfway the demands of the Warsaw Pact states. Allegedly the principle continues to be valid: to reduce conventional forces of the East, while the West would calmly retain for itself supremacy in atomic weapons for deployment on the battlefield. In any case, the possibility of escalation, on which the Atlantic strategy of 'intimidation' is based, will be maintained," DIE WELT wrote. The Atlantists' notions on the course of the detente were completely illustrated by Federal Minister of Foreign Affairs Genscher. The endeavors aimed at standardization of weapons of NATO member states must allegedly lead to an increase of the pact's striking force and must not be a pretext for a further reduction of its combat forces.

The meeting took place at the headquarters of the party Central Committee. Sammech Norodom Sihanouk was accompanied by his wife, Princess Monique Sihanouk; Sarin Chhak, member of the NUPC Central Committee Polithuro and RGNUC minister of foreign affairs; and Keath Chhon, candidate member of the NUPC Central Committee Polithuro.

[Text] Comrade National Assembly deputies, the present session of the National Assembly is an event of great national significance. It takes place at a time between two important 5-year periods of the socialist development of Bulgaria, on the eve of the 11th BCP Congress. The work completed at the session reflects the precongress spirit and our drive toward new heights in the building of the developed socialist society.

Two important matters demonstrate the importance of the plan now to be adopted. It is the connecting link between two 5-year plans periods—the sixth and the seventh. At the same time it is the beginning of a new approach to planning, which the party has recently worked out and is now implementing. The 1976 plan more fully reflects the objective needs of our society and the directives of the party; it more successfully mobilizes our national resources in the name of man, his welfare and comprehensive development.

Each of our plans has its place in the socialist development of Bulgaria; each one is a step higher in the life of the people and the country. And if today we are able to set ourselves new and bigger tasks, it is because we start from an optimistic reality—the expected successful fulfillment of the 1975 plan and the Sixth 5-Year Plan.

The basic measure for the upward development of any economy is the growth rate of national income. This year it will increase about 9 percent compared with 1974. This is chiefly the result of the increased social labor productivity which secured more than 95 percent of the national income growth.

The high rate was also largely insured by the increase of industrial production which is the leading branch of our economy. We expect a more than 10 percent production increase in the last year of the 5- year plan.

The production of electrical power in the January-October period went up 10 percent compared with the same period last year. Now all the needs of the country are satisfied, which is a prerequisite for the normal supply of electrical power to the national economy and the successful carrying out of the production programs in all branches.

The production of many basic products of the chemical industry has considerably expanded.

Machine-building production increased particularly fast. The party program on the structuring of machine-building, worked out at the ninth party congress, continues to be implemented.

We expect that the plan of the light, food and catering industries, which produced more mass consumer goods, will be overfulfilled.

The year now coming to an end was not a favorable one for agriculture. Chiefly because of this, we will not have the amounts planned for some produce. However, as a result of the timely measures undertaken by the party and the government and thanks to the active participation of the cooperative farmers and mechanizers, the overall agricultural production of the country increased by about 8 percent compared with last year. The results of cattle-breeding are considerably better. It is expected that the plan for the overall production volume will be overfulfilled by 2 percent and larger quantities of meat, milk and eggs have already been secured.

[Text of reply by Norodom Sihanouk to President Tito's toast at a formal dinner in honor of Norodom Sihanouk, at Brioni on 16 December]

[Text] Highly esteemed Mr Marshal, president of the republic:

It is with feelings of great excitement and with great pride that I am today again in your excellency's company. As early as in 1966 you extended most precious friendship, from the first hour of our struggle against the imperialist aggressor and for national salvation of the Cambodian people. You extended full recognition to the legal government of Cambodia, as well as to the Royal Government of the National Union of Cambodia (RGNUC), on behalf of the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia [SFRY]. This was an unreserved support, complete solidarity and a many-sided assistance with which you have in the greatest possible extent contributed to the victory of our just cause. In this connection, it is necessary to stress the enormous prestige and popularity which you enjoy in the world.

Even at a time when a large part of international public opinion believed that we had no chance to be victorious, because our aggressors and neocolonizers belonged to the richest and the most powerful country of the world, which is known as invincible, your excellency not only adhered to the principle of extending the necessary support to a small people, who became a victim of injustice, but has never doubted throughout the victorious outcome of our struggle. This is possible if the people, guided by pure patriotism and awareness of national duty, dare to oppose the enemy and accept all sacrifices.

The example which 30 years ago the very courageous Yugoslav peoples set under your heroic leadership was also present in our country and assured us of the final success in our struggle for national liberation.

Mr Marshal,

When I left Phnom Penh, all the fighters, men and women, as well as all the leaders of liberated Cambodia asked me to convey to you their cordial and deep respect and to assure you that the victory which we have won, and which has no equal in our history of 2,000 years, is at the same time yours and the victory of the entire SFRY.

Mr Marshal, president of the republic, Mrs Broz,

Allow me to express my deep gratitude, the gratitude of my wife, and of the Cambodian delegation for the welcome which you have accorded to us, for the great honor which the Yugoslav people and you personally have accorded us since our arrival in the SFRY. At the same time, we are grateful to you for your exceptional friendship and respect which you demonstrate to the Cambodian people, its NUFC the people's military forces for national liberation, the National Union Government and to the head of state.

Cambodia is very proud of being linked to Yugoslavia with an indestructable friendship and militant solidarity which have insured the victory of our common ideals regarding freedom, justice, peace and progress, as well as the further success of the nonalined movement. This movement does not cease to spread; nonalinement is the best guarantee of independence and national sovereignity and also is the best, most realistic and most effective contribution to relaxation of international tension. Monalinement contributes to peaceful coexistence between the rich and poor, big, medium=sized and small peoples and countries of the world.

Mr Marshal, president of the republic, Mrs Broz, excellencies, ladies and gentlemen,

The huge war of 5 years which imperialism as the aggressor had imposed on Cambodia caused enormous losses to our nation (more than 600,000 dead, about 1 million seriously wounded, more than 2 million citizens who lost their homes, villages, cattle and so forth) and enormous destruction to our country [few words indistinct] mainly by shells and bombs of the enemy air force, including intensive and exhaustive air raids by hundreds of B-52 flying fortresses.

However, the Cambodian people remain as courageous in peace as they were at war. Since 17 April 1975—the day of the complete liberation of the homeland and of the capital, Phnom Penh—the Cambodian people with body and soul and with doubled enthusiasm derived from the victory set about the gigantic task of remewing the country and of developing a democratic equal society in which there will be neither exploiters nor exploited, neither rich nor poor, neither social injustice nor social [word indistinct]. Cambodia will have an independent national economy.

After 8 months of stremmous methodical work, our revolutionary people have succeeded in repairing everything that is necessary for the normalization of the social and economic life of the country (roads, bridges, ports, airports, factories) and in providing a new base for the national economy. Thanks to the introduction of irrigation systems in the rice and other fields, it has been possible to double agricultural production compared with the past and also to insure the development of the economy which is based on agriculture and on the natural resources of the country, on our own forces, our own work and our own sacrifices. Under all circumstances we have succeeded in remaining independent masters of our work and our fate.

Immediately after the war our most difficult problems were: food, clothing and medicaments for 7.5 million Cambodians. Making use of the resources of our agriculture and industry [words indistinct] by this we have succeeded in preserving our sovereignty and independence.

To insure lasting sovereignty and independence we have chosen one path forever, the path of nonalinement, as the basis of our policy and relations with foreign countries. Cambodia has sided with socialist Yugoslavia from the very beginning of the nonalinement movement.

Together with all other countries which are in favor of (?revolutionary) truth and progress, Cambodia accepts Marshal Josip Broz Tito as a great here of all of mankind. As early as in his youth he devoted himself with heart and body to the struggle for the victory of the noblest ideas of all the peoples of the world, thus writing for his homeland [passage indistinct] national history in an admirable way which—if this is altogether necessary—testifies to the real greatness of socialist Yugoslavia, its revolutionary peoples and its highly esteemed and beloved president.

Excellency, ladies and gentlemen, allow me to raise this glass to the health, long life and happiness of his excellency, Marshal Josip Broz Tito and Mrs Broz, to the glory of the SFRY to the progress of the Yugoslav peoples, to the indelible friendship which forever links the Cambodian and Yugoslav peoples.
