

SIHANOUK, OTHERS CALL AT PRG EMBASSY IN PEKING 30 APR

[Text] Cambodia, 3 May, AKI--On 29 April Samdech Norodom Sihanouk, chief of state and chairman of the NUFC, sent the following message to Khieu Samphan, RGNUC deputy prime minister, minister of national defense and CPNLAF commander-in-chief:

SIHANOUK DEMANDS CAMBODIAN UN SEAT BE TURNED OVER TO RGNUC

[Text] Peking, May 3 (AFP)--Prince Norodom Sihanouk has called for Cambodia's seat in the United Nations to be turned over "without delay" to the Royal Government of Khmer National Union (RGNUC). In a statement dated yesterday and delivered here today, Prince Sihanouk, as Cambodia's head of state, called on UN member states which have already recognized the RGNUC to advise UN Secretary General Kurt Waldheim to take three measures.

"First, to replace without delay the charlatan 'flag' of the defunct 'Khmer Preublic' with the authentic flag of Kampuchea (Cambodia)", the prince wrote.

"Second, to make clear to the traitors belonging to the so-called 'permanent delegation of the Khmer Republic at the United Nations' that they must without delay evacuate the quarters of the Cambodian delegation, which belong to the RGNUC and to the Kingdom of Cambodia", he continued.

"Third, to invite those traitors and war criminals to leave UN territory without delay", he concluded. Prince Sihanouk's statement echoes a demand to the same effect already made by the RGNUC.

Charge d'Affaires Tran Binh and Ambassador Nguyen Trong Vinh expressed sincere gratitude to the fine greetings of Samdech Head of State Norodom Sihanouk and proposed a toast to hail the great victories of the Vietnamese and Cambodian people in the anti-U.S. cause for national salvation and to wish the militant solidarity between the two people last firmly and finely forever.
