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SIHANOUK OUTLINES POLICIES AFTER LON NOL'S FALL

AFRIQUE-ASIE Interview

[Text] Paris, March 20 (AFP)--Prince Norodom Sihanouk of Cambodia, in an interview published here today, praised United Nations Secretary-General Kurt Waldheim for refusing to go to Phnom Penh to launch "unrealizable negotiations" called for [by] the UN General Assembly. The prince predicted the government of Cambodian President Lon Nol would fall within a few weeks if United States aid is cut off or within a few months if the aid continues.

In the interview with the weekly AFRIQUE-ASIE, Prince Sihanouk, who is chairman of the Cambodian National United Front (NUFC) listed the following points of Cambodian foreign policy after the projected fall of Marshal Lon Nol:

--Maximum development of "friendship solidarity and cooperation" with about 60 states which "proved to be genuine friends" between 1970 and 1975--mostly Arab and African countries.

--Broadening the "circle" of foreign friends, regardless of ideology, to include all those who respect the national independence, territorial integrity and ideological choice of tomorrow's Cambodia.

--Aid from big powers will only be accepted if it is "absolutely unconditional and respectful of our dignity, as is the aid from the People's Republic of China."

--No relations with "Zionist Israel" nor with the governments in Taipei, Seoul and Saigon.

--The representative of the Palestine Liberation Organization, "which for us is the state of Palestine," will have the rank and prerogatives of an ambassador.

--No official relations with the United States if it continues to grant aid and protection to the "Phnom Penh regime."

--No official relations with Thailand, unless it eliminates foreign military bases and respects the territorial integrity of Cambodia, especially regarding the Prah Vihar temple which the International Court of Justice has "confirmed as belonging to Cambodia."

[Excerpts] Hong Kong, March 21 (AFP)--The Lon Nol regime may last another three months, six months or a year, Prince Norodom Sihanouk, head of the Government of National Union of Cambodia (GRUNK), told the Hong Kong-based FAR EASTERN ECONOMIC REVIEW [FEER]. This is so, he said, because the strategy of the Red Khmer forces is "not to bring our offensives directly on Phnom Penh but rather to lead a war of attrition."

In an exclusive interview published here today, the self-exiled leader also reaffirmed that "we refuse, and shall refuse, any negotiation" with the Lon Nol government, or any "Laos type" solution. "Henry Kissinger, who is very intelligent, knows what to believe on this matter," said Sihanouk, but being also "very Machiavellian," he manages to deceive President Ford and others into thinking that the GRUNK may accept something less than "defeat and unconditional surrender in the not-too-distant future" of the Lon Nol side.

"I dare hope," he said, that the regime that will take their place will be "sufficiently liberal," and "the Red Khmer leaders have even let me know very recently that the Cambodia of the FUNK (National United Front of Cambodia) will not be communist." They also asked him to remain head of state for life, he noted, but he would accept the post to "look after foreign affairs only," leaving the actual running of the country to the Red Khmers. The new regime will be socialist, combining the right to private (but not foreign) ownership with collectivisation, and religious freedom will be guaranteed, the FEER was told.

[The NUFC and the RGNUC Will Come To Administer Phnom Penh and Restore Peace in Cambodia Without Impairing the Security of Any Country, Near or Far]

[Text] Cambodia, 20 March, AKI--The Cambodian nation and people, the CPNLAF, NUFC and RGNUC have several times reaffirmed the internal and foreign policies of the NUFC, and the recent second national congress of Cambodia again clearly presented them in its statement.
