THE PAPER SAID: WORKERS AT ALL FACTORIES AND ENTERPRISES IN
THE CAPITAL CITY HAVE TAKEN PART IN THE FIGHT WHETHER IN DAYTIME
OR AT NIGHT. THEY WERE AMONG THE FIRST TO GO AND CAPTURE PARACHUTING
U.S. PILOTS. AT ALL FACTORIES PRODUCTION RESUMED IMMEDIATELY AFTER
THE ALL-CLEAR. IN SOME CASES, WORKERS KEPT THEIR MACHINES GOING
EVEN WHILE ENEMY PLANES WERE BOMBING AND ROCCKETTING. AFTER EACH
RAID THE CITY AGAIN SHONE WITH ELECTRIC LIGHT, TRAFFIC REMAINED
OPEN, AND PRODUCTS CONTINUED TO COME OFF THE LINE.

TYPICAL OF THE WORKERS DAUNTLESSNESS IN FACE OF THE ENEMY'S
BRUTALITIES ARE THE WORKERS OF FACTORY YYY WHO HAVE MORE THAN ONCE
CONFRONTED DIVEBOMBING U.S. PLANES, AND WHO HAVE NOTT EVEN FOR
A MINUTE LEFT THEIR MACHINES IDLE. ON A BATTERY POSITION, STOKER
LE QUY NGHI CALMLY COMMANDED A UNIT OF THE FACTORY'S HOME GUARD.
A BOMB FELL NEARBY BUT THE UNIT KEPT BLAZING AWAY AT THE PLANES.
