[Text] South Vietnam June 15 GPS--Samdech Norodom Sihanouk, head of state of the Kingdom of Cambodia, has sent a message to Mr. Huynh Tan Phat, president of the Provisional Revolutionary Government of the Republic of South Vietnam, informing him that "the Kingdom of Cambodia recognizes de Jure the Provisional Revolutionary Government of the Republic of South Vietnam".

This decision was also announced at a graduation ceremony at the military academy on June 14.

Samdech Norodom Sihanouk, on this occasion, reasserted that Cambodia will continue to resolutely and fully support the Vietnamese people in their struggle against the U.S. imperialists, to defend their independence. He said that Cambodia actively supports the Vietnamese people's resolute demand for an unconditional withdrawal of the US and satellite troops from South Vietnam, so as to enable the South Vietnamese people to settle themselves their own affairs without foreign interference.

Samdech Norodom Siahnouk emphasized that it is the Vietnamese people and not the U.S. that decide their destiny.
