THO MEETS SIHANOUK, OTHER NONALINED LEADERS IN ALGIERS

[Text] According to an Algiers-based LPA correspondent, on the afternoon of 4 September 1973 at the center of the Fourth Nonalined Summit Conference, Samdech Norodom Sihanouk, Cambodian chief of state and chairman of the NUFC, called on Mr Nguyen Huu Tho, chairman of the NFLSV Central Committee Presidium and chairman of the PRGRSV's Advisory Council.

Chairman Nguyen Huu Tho warmly received and cordially conferred with Chief of State Norodom Sihanouk. At the reception Chairman Nguyen Huu Tho and Samdech Chief of State Norodom Sihanouk unanimously held that the PRGRSV and the RGNUC, which have long been bound together in the struggle against U.S. imperialist aggression, would certainly cooperate with each other in contributing to making the fourth summit conference a success.
