SUBJ: (C) Assistance for the Founding of the Cambodian People's United Front by Sub-Region 2, COSVE.

(C) (12 pages, handwritten; B-3) Draft of a plan, undated, prepared by a member of an unidentified Rear Base Area Party Committee ((possibly Rear Base Area Section of Sub-Region 2, COSVN)), pertains to an assistance program in support of the friendly ((Cambodian revolutionary)) movement.

Document states that in compliance with a directive of TWC ((COSVN)) and based upon its capabilities, the Rear Base Area Section was to furnish a group of cadre and personnel to provide assistance to the friends ((pro-Sihanouk Cambodians)) and, in the meantime, was to promote closer relations with friendly local ((Cambodian)) authorities and units ((in Svay Rieng Province)) by pro-viding them with necessary military and political aid depending on their requirements.

The missions of this group were to assemble the populace at thum's ((villages)) and towns for the organization of a Front for National Reunification of Cambodia; build up guerrilla and special action forces to cope with the war under all circumstances; form cadre and guerrilla elements, particularly at fum ((hamlet)) and khum ((village)) levels; and organize special action elements among the WK ((possibly meaning Vietnamese residents in Cambodia)) in Sway Rieng Province. The areas of emphasis were Prasaut and Unit Fen.

In the execution of the assistance missions, the members should attempt to demonstrate to the Cambodian people the friendship of the Government ((meaning the Provisional Revolutionary Government of the Republic of SVN)).

Document focuses on the organization and training of the guerrille force at khum and srok ((district)); on security activities aimed at suppressing traitors and counterrevolutionaries; and on social warfare such as medical assistance and sanitary activities.

In order to carry out the assigned missions, the assistance group would consist of one 24-member section headed by military and political cadre, reinforced by one B ((pla-"toon)) and four translators. This group would be armed

with 20 AK's, 50 CKC's, two B-40's, and 20 kilograms of C4 explosive with an amount of detonators.
