V. LIBERATION RADIO SUMMARIZES
CAMBODIA SOLIDARITY WEEK RESPONSES

[Liberation Radio, clandestine, in Vietnamese to South Viet-Nam, 2300 GMT, 15 November 1970.]

[Commentary: "All progressive mankind is looking forward a Cambodia which is fighting and winning"]

The fraternal Cambodian people's struggle against aggressive U.S. imperialism and its henchmen for independence, freedom, peace, and neutrality has enjoyed the sympathy and strong support of all progressive mankind. The world people in Europe, Asia, American, Australia, and Africa have raised shouts of indignation, have vehemently condemned the U.S. imperialists for waging an armed aggression against Cambodia and expanding the war to all of Indochina, and have demanded that they end their dirty aggressive war and immediately withdraw all U.S. and mercenary troops from Viet-Nam, Cambodia, and Laos, and let the three Indochinese peoples decide their own fates, without foreign interference. Their warm sentiments and practical support have been manifested through concrete actions during international solidarity week with Cambodia in the anti-U.S. struggle from 9 to 16 November 1970.

During this week of solidarity with Cambodia, in the socialist and nationalist states and right in the heart of capitalist countries that include the United States, a strong worldwide struggle movement has been launched in numerous forms such as demonstrations, meetings, and contributions of money and medicine in support of the Indochinese peoples' struggle against U.S. aggression. The world people have unceasingly demanded that the United States end its aggression and withdraw all its U.S. and satellite troops from Indochina and have condemned and bared its stubborn attitude and its perfidious aggressive design which was revealed in the so-called Nixon peace initiative.

The Afro-Asian Solidarity Organization Conference held in Tripoli from 9 to 11 November with the participation of 70 countries passed a resolution, warmly supporting the anti-U.S. struggle of the Vietnamese, Cambodian, and Laotians. The session of the World Federation of Democratic Youth held in Sofia also passed a resolution, vehemently condemning the U.S. imperialists' continued aggression against Cambodia, fully supporting the Cambodians' valiant struggle under the leadership of the NUFK and RGNUK, Samdech Chief of State Norodom Sihanouk's five-point statement of 23 March 1970, and the RGNUK's statement of 11 October 1970

The session appealed to the world youth to further step up and turn the world youth movement into an international youth movement to work for the final victory of the Vietnamese, Cambodia, and Laotians and decided to take Cambodia's National Day,, 9 November as a world youth day of solidarity with the Cambodian youths.

United with the Cambodians and Laotians in struggling against aggressive U.S. imperialism, the Vietnamese have enthusiastically responded to the international week of solidarity with the Cambodians. At the solemn meeting opening the international week of solidarity with the fraternal Cambodian people, Dr. Phung Van Cung, Vice Chairman of the NFLSV Central Committee Presidium, on behalf of the South Vietnamese people, reasserted the unswerving stand of the NFLSV and RSVN PRG that fully sympathize with and warmly support the Cambodian people's just and brave struggle under the firm and clear-sighted leadership of the NUFK and RGNUK headed by Samdech Norodom Sihanouk who has been struggling valiantly to regain the sacred national rights. In the DRV as well as in the Laotian liberated areas, a week of solidarity with the Cambodians has begun with the concrete and practical actions of their companions in struggle who stand in the same combat trench.

It is clear that the Cambodian people's glorious struggle, though waged over a very short period of time, has scored extremely brilliant victories and has created shining pages in Cambodia's history of the struggle for independence and freedom. This forward progress will surely lead to a steady future and complete victory. The fact that this struggle is consistent with the tendency of this era and the overall and great victories of the Cambodians has created a deep and widely-resounding echo in the hearts of the world's people and have won the sympathy and profound understanding of progressive mankind and freedom- and justice-loving people in the United States.

The fact that many governments in the world have recognized the RGNUK and have warmly acclaimed the NUFK's political program and the fact that the third conference of nonaligned countries in Lusaka boycotted the Lon Nol puppet clique and warmly hailed the RGNUK as the only legal and genuine representative of the Cambodian people have brilliantly manifested the great international prestige of the NUFK and RGNUK and have dealt a blow to the U.S. imperialists' malicious neocolonialist policy; it has exposed before the tribunal of world public opinion the so-called republican regime of the Lon Nol-Matak clique, a monster emerging from the mouths of U.S. guns.

At present, the Cambodians have liberated more than two thirds of their territory and more than three million people. The people's administrations at all levels have been set up throughout the country and supported by the broad and steadfast solidarity bloc and the national liberation armed forces. They have been advancing the patriotic war toward greater victories.

The South Vietnamese people, NFLSV, and PRG warmly acclaim the Cambodians' overall, great victories which they take as their own.
