(C) (6 pages, handwritten; E-3) Guide, undated, originated by an unidentified agency ((possibly an agency subordinate to Political Staff Department, Headquarters, SVNLA)), provides a plan for the organization of the Front for National Reunification of Cambodia at hamlet and village levels.

Document states that the mission of the related Front Committee is to build a new government to replace the present ((Lon Nol's)) administration. The Front will lead the ((Cambodian)) labor class and those compatriots who wish to provide support to Prince Sihanouk. To accomplish the three major tasks outlined by Prince Sihanouk, it is to destroy the Lon Nol Administration, maintain a good friendship between Vietnamese and Cambodians, and to resist Americans.

The specific missions of the Front Committee are to: (1) Reunify the ((Cambodian)) people into a single bloc in order to achieve the three tasks outlined by Prince Sihanouk and establish a new country ((Red Cambodia)); (2) form the ((Cambodian)) people into liberation organizations such as youths', women's, teenagers', and old people's liberation organizations, and build up local armed forces, and the Khmer Liberation Army; (3) lead these liberation organizations to counter US sweep operations and eliminate spies and other lackeys who attempt to sabotage security in Fums ((hamlets)) and villages; (4) encourage production, develop a public-health service, raise the people's cultural level and improve the people's living conditions; and (5) educate the ((Cambodian)) people to love the Khmer Fatherland, and instigate hatred and resentment toward the US imperialists and the Lon Nol clique.

In general terms, the Front Committee should resolutely and correctly implement the appeal of Prince Sihanouk ((broadcast)) on 23 Mar 70.

Document further provides instructions on the personnel of hamlet and village Front Committees and missions assigned to each committee member. Normally, each village Front Committee should consist of from five to seven committee members, and each hamlet Front Committee from three to five members.

(C) CDEC COMMENT: Document was captured with others referring to Agencies of Border Defense Section, Border Area Office, Political Staff Department, Headquarters, SVNLA. It indicates that the North Vietnamese Communists have started an insurgency movement in Cambodia, utilizing the same methods which were successful in creating the insurgency movement against the Republic of Vietnam.
