

POREIGN OFFICE WITHHOLDS COMMENT ON SIHANOUK 'ATTACK'

[Text] Jakarta April 8 (ANTARA) -- The foreign office Tuesday [8 April] did not want to comment on a verbal attack against Indonesia by Prince Norodom Sihanouk. Sihanouk stated in Peking Monday that Indonesia was one of the worst mortal enemies of independent and non-aligned Cambodia. Sihanouk charged Foreign Minister Adam Malik with lying and slandering in stating that the Red Khmers had made approaches to Indonesia in view of a Cambodian settlement and that Prince Sihanouk himself could be contacted.

Sources collected by ANTARA said Foreign Minister Adam Malik had never made a statement to the effect that Cambodian insurgents had contacted Indonesia in a bid to find a settlement to the Cambodian crisis. Malik had only appealed to the warring parties to come to the conference table to find a peaceful settlement.



NATION MAINTAINS STAND ON PRGRSV, CAMBODIA RECOGNITION

[Text] The government has no intention of changing Norway's diplomatic relations with the parties in South Vietnam or in Cambodia until the situation has been fully clarified. Nor is there any question of the PRGRSV being allowed to establish representation in Norway on the Swedish model. Foreign Minister Knut Prydenlund said this to the Storting yesterday after Finn Gustavsen, group leader of the Socialist Left Party, took up the question of recognition of the PRGRSV and the Royal Government of National Union of Cambodia.

Prydenlund recalled that Norway in principle attached crucial importance to how much physical control a party had over the territory before an eventual international law recognition. As far as Vietnam was concerned, the foreign minister said that developments were now so rapid and the situation so fluid that the government thought it right to wait for full clarification before considering the question of changing relations with the parties. He believed that the possibility of a situation leading to political negotiations and a political solution should not be excluded.

On the subject of Cambodia, Foreign Minister Prydenlund said that Norway did not have diplomatic relations with any of the parties in this conflict. The government would wait for clarification on this also.

Gustavsen believed that there was no doubt about who now had control of South Vietnam and that there had long been no doubt about Cambodia. Norway should at least consider allowing the PRGRSV to establish a general delegation in Norway, he said. This was rejected by Frydenlund.

SV Supports PRGRSV Recognition

SIHANOUK, KHIEU SAPHAN DENY CONTACT WITH 'OTHER SIDE'

[Text] Peking, April 10, 1975 (HSINHUA) -- The alleged "contacts" between the "two sides of the Khmer" in Bangkok were denounced as rumour by Samdech Norodom Sihanouk, head of state, and chairman of the National United Front of Cambodia and Khieu Samphan, deputy prime minister, minister of national defence, of the Royal Government of National Union of Cambodia and commander-in-chief of the Cambodian People's National Liberation Armed Forces, in their statement on April 8, according to AKI.

Samdech Sihanouk's statement says: "On behalf of the NUFC, the RGNUC and the CPNLAF, I denounced the gross and despicable rumour spread by the authorities of Thailand, and reiterate the total and irreversible refusal of the Cambodian resistance to negotiate with the super traitors -- Lon Nol, long Boret, Saukam Khoy, Hang Thu Hak, Ung Bun Hor, Sak Sutsakhan, Lon Non, Pan Sothi and Keukky Lim."

"This is a vile manoeuvre any dignified statesman would reject."
