The situation in Cambodia has worsened. The pro-American rightist clique has overthrown Sihanouk and seised power. In fact, they have destroyed the independence and neutrality of Cambodia, and spoiled the friendship between this country and curselves. They are steering Cambodia toward a reactionary regime, even though they still maintain neutrality and diplomatic relations with the socialist countries. For this reason, they have initiated demonstrations against us, promoted racial segregation, and encouraged their people to mistreat and exploit the Vietnamese residents in Cambodia. In particular they have intensified all espionage activities, and will probably create conditions for the US and Puppets to conduct military operations against our forces stationed in the border areas.

In face of such a situation, the propaganda and training sections of all local areas and units must perform the following tasks:

1. Make all Party headquarters and Party Chapters understand that the incidents which took place in Cambodia were promoted by the US. This is an indication that they are confused because of their serious failure in Vistnam. This is also evidence of their stubborrysm and persistence in prolonging the war in Indo-China. Although the situation in Cambodia can create some temporary difficulties for us in the border areas, it will not save the US and its Cambodian henchmen from an inevitable defeat. On the contrary, the political action movement of the Cambodian people against the US and the pro-US reactionary government in support of the Chief of State Sihanouk will develop widely and place the US and its henchmen in a dangerous situation. The US will be driven into a deadlock, and it will be entengled in a great deal of difficulty. There will be favorable conditions for the liberation movement in Cambodia to develop, and for our troops and people to fight and win.

2. The Party headquarters and Party Chapters must be made aware of the above situation and prevent Party members from being surprised and effected because of it. They must encourage the Party members to remain caim and have high determination to overcome all difficulties. Our cadre must seize the opportunity to accomplish their immediate and future tasks, and create advantageous conditions for us to achieve

Upon receipt of this communique, all local areas and units will disseminate its contents within their organizations, together with the statement made by the Provisional acvolutionary Government of SVN concerning the coup d'etat in Cambodia. They will make their personnel understand our viewpoint and attitude towards the recent incidents in Cambodia. Meanwhile, they will reveal the distorted propaganda and false accusations of the US and Puppets aimed at creating racial segregation and destroying the age old friendship between the Vietnamese and Khmer peoples who are fighting the US for the salvation of the Indo-Chinese
