**PRIORITY**

I. SUBJECT: Information on the 4th Political Indoctrination Session for women, organized by the Lê Thi Riêng School, COSVN.

II. CIRCUMSTANCES OF CAPTURE:

The document was captured by friendly forces in Southern Mimot, Cambodia on 16 May 70.

III. CONTENTS:

This is a 200 page notebook of Nguyễn Thị Cõ, aka Tử Cõ, a trainee of the 4th Political Indoctrination Session, Lê Thi Riêng School, COSVN. The exploitation of the document reveals the following information:

1. The 4th Political Indoctrination Session for Women organized by the "Lê Thi Riêng School":

a. In Mar 70, the 4th Political Indoctrination Session, organized by the Lê Thi Riêng School, COSVN, was opened for 20 female delegates throughout the region. The female delegates came from Bến Tre, Mỹ Tho, Kiến Tường, SR1, SR2, SR5, Tây Ninh, Bình Long, Phước Long, Quảng Đức, and Lâm Đồng Provinces.

The delegates were as follows:

Bến Tre ((Province)): Sister Minh Đức

Of the 20 delegates, three were district Party Committee members, four were Party cell leaders, seven were Chapter Party Committee members, and six were Party members.

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c. The youngest trainee was 24 years old and the oldest was 53. The average age was 36.

d. Instructors in charge were all women, including Mrs Ba Đình (aka Nguyễn Thị Đình), Sáu Hạnh, Tư Thoại, Tám Thanh, Hai Đước, and Sáu Tuyết.

e. The training documents are very important and require an extensive ((political)) background knowledge to understand them.

Subjects of the various lessons are as follows: "Ideological methods based on dialectical materialism and disagreement over causality in dealing with ideological problems"; class struggles; class dissension in SVN; revolutionary guidelines applied in the South; revolutionary socialism in the North; the Party's strategic guidelines; new situation and missions for 1970 (to counter the de-Americanization and pacification plans); Resolution 9; Directive 6/CT70, issued by COSVN (dated 4 Apr 70), on the situation in Cambodia after the coup d'etat; and Vietnamese Communist missions of "providing assistance for Cambodian Communists as described in the plan for the Indochina Revolution." In addition, there were lessons on the role and responsibilities of the liberation women; organization of liberation associations, especially the women's associations; women proselyting task; and female participation in governmental organization in both the North and the South."

The training course was completed on 25 Apr 70.

2. Information on the contents of COSVN Directive 6/CT70 (concerning the situation in Cambodia):

This lesson was given by Mrs Hai Đước during the training course on 4 Apr 70. It consisted of two parts:

Part I: The evolution of the situation in Cambodia after the  
18 Mar 70 coup d'etat.

Part II: Communist Vietnamese policy toward Cambodia.

The document said that the US and RVN governments supported General Lon Nol in overthrowing Sihanouk. Also, the US and RVN had hoped to create conditions favorable to chasing them from the Vietnamese-Cambodian border.

In Part II, with the title "Develop our victories and positively carry out coming missions to support the friendly ((Cambodian)) resistance," the document was written as follows: (textually extracted from the document):

"We must strengthen our bases in the border area and maintain the friendship between the two nations ((Cambodia and North Vietnam)). Only by doing so can we maintain our leadership agencies, because we are fighting the enemy and supporting the Revolution in Cambodia at the same time. We must provide assistance and indoctrination for male and female youths (Party and Group members) to make them display their high patriotic spirit by standing up with the entire Cambodian population to oppose the Lon Nol government. In addition, we must motivate male and female Vietnamese resident youths (in Cambodia) to return to their native country and join the Revolution."

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Vietnamese Communist organization of the cabinet and governmental system:

The instructor for this lesson was Mrs Sáu Tuyết (on 10 Apr 70). She used two charts. The first chart deals with the cabinet and the local governmental system, and the second chart deals only with the administration system, the People's Courts, and "Inspection Hall." The second chart was the organization from Central Headquarters to province, district, and village levels. The lesson did not reveal whether this was the organizational system of the North or the South (in the future).

These two charts are the true copies of the original text. They are attached in the annex.

IV. CDEC COMMENT ((RVN ELEMENT)):

1. This is a very valuable document which provides us with more accurate information on the Lê Thị Riêng School of COSVN and especially the "organization of the Communist authorities" (in theory).

2. Concerning Directive 6/CT70 of COSVN: Though it was undated, it was certainly drafted after the 18 Mar 70 coup d'etat in Cambodia. It helps us fully understand the Communist policy toward the war.

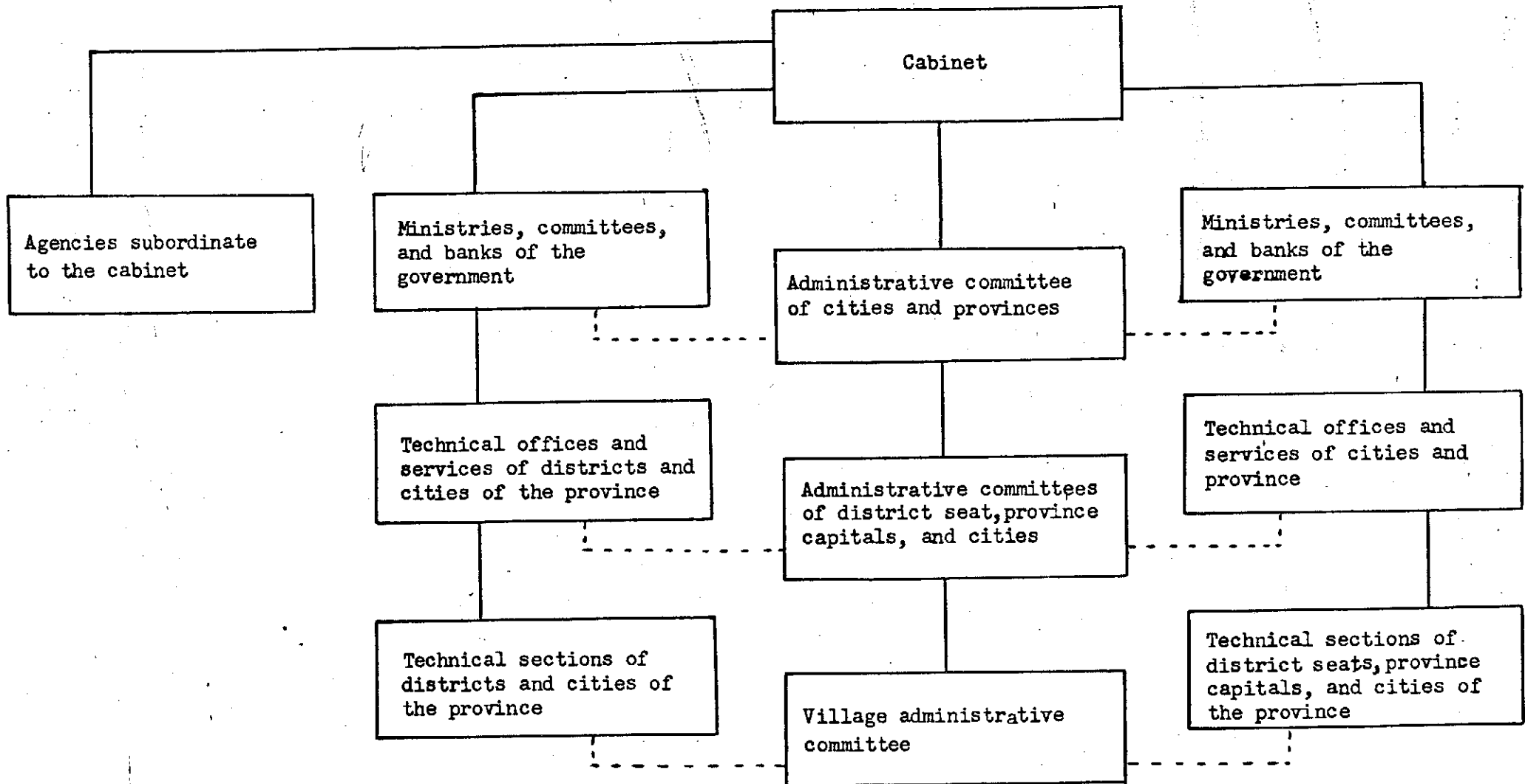

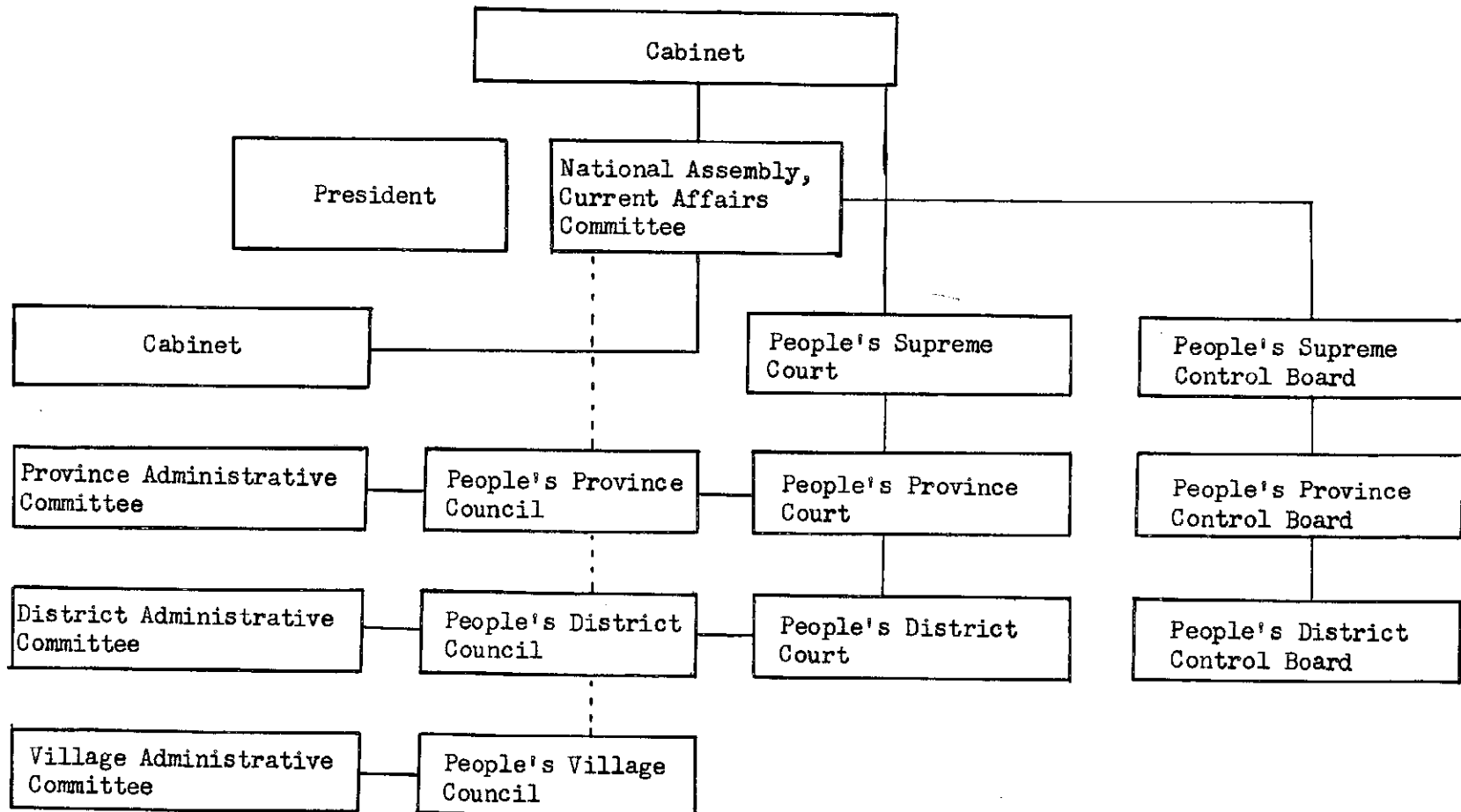
ORGANIZATIONAL CHART OF THE COMMUNIST CABINET AND THE GOVERNMENTAL SYSTEM IN ((S)) VN:
